# What are Large Learning Models? (LLMs)

Large Language Models are like super-smart computers that try to understand and talk like humans.

**Super-Smart Computer Robots:** Think of them as a computer program that's really good at using words, reading stories, and even writing like a person does.

**Built Like a Brain:** Inside, they are built using something called neural networks. This is a fancy way of saying they're designed like a human brain, using connections called "artificial neurons."

**Learning from Everything:** They learn by reading tons of stuff like books, websites, and even what people are saying online. The more they read, the smarter they get.

**Practice Makes Perfect:** Just like you might practice a sport to get better, these computer programs keep learning and practicing with more and more information. They keep getting better at understanding and using words the more they practice.



# What is Generative AI?



Generative AI refers to a type of artificial intelligence that has the ability to **generate** new data that is similar to the data it was trained on.

It can create original content, such as images, text, audio, or even videos, without direct human input.

Generative AI uses advanced algorithms, typically based on deep learning models to understand patterns and relationships in the training data.

During the training process, the model learns to generate new data that resembles the examples it has seen. For example, if it was trained on a dataset of cat images, it could produce new images of cats that look similar to real cats.

One of the fascinating aspects of generative AI is its ability to create content that didn't exist before. It can be used in various creative applications, like generating artwork, music, or even writing stories.

# Chat GPT is both an LLM and generative AI



**Chat GPT falls under the category of both a large learning model and generative AI, combining its extensive language understanding with the ability to generate text.**

**Large Learning Model:** GPT is a large learning model . GPT-3, for instance, has 175 billion parameters, making it one of the largest language models in existence. This vast number of parameters allows GPT to process and understand language with remarkable complexity and accuracy.

**Generative AI:** GPT is also an example of generative AI because it can generate new and original text based on the patterns it learned during training. When you interact with GPT and ask it questions or provide prompts, it generates responses that are not pre-programmed but rather generated on the spot by the model.

# Chat GPT launched in November 2022




When it launched in November 2022, Chat GPT3.5 became the first Generative AI tool that

1. Was very easy for consumers to interact with. It has a simple interface and it's easy to ask and receive information
2. Chat GPT 3.5 was trained on 175 billion parameters making it the most sophisticated generative ai tool

Consumers had never experienced an AI tool that was humanlike in the quality of its answers

# Ways businesses and marketers are using Chat GPT

# There are now two versions of Chat GPT



Chat GPT 3.5 which is free

- It has no knowledge of events after Sept 2021
- It cannot access web pages

Chat GPT 4 (Called Pro) which costs €20 / month

**Chat GPT 4 gives you ...**

- It has been trained on data after Sept 2021
- The data is was trained on it much larger so results are more comprehensive.
- It can access web pages
- It can create images using DALL-E
- You can attach a file e.g. Pdf, word doc, image and it ask it to analyse / summarise it
- You can use Chat GPT Plugins and advanced features to make it even more useful e.g. Data analytics
- You can create custom GPTs

And there are other Generative AI tools that have emerged in the market



**For generating written content – based on LLMs there are 2 other big options**

### **1. Bing**

Bing's search engine has integrated Chat GPT into the search results

### **2. Google Bard**

Google has launched their alternative to Chat GPT called Google Bard and is starting to incorporate it into search results.



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# What is prompt engineering?



**This is a phrase you will hear when it comes to how you ask Chat GPT or any of these chat bots for information**

When you ask Chat GPT something it is a prompt

If your prompts are poor you won't get as much out of Chat GPT


A prompt can be a question, a phrase, or several paragraphs. The more specific the prompt is, the better the response.

Writing the perfect prompt — prompt engineering — is critical to ensure the Chat GPT response is not only factually correct but crafted exactly as you intended to best deliver information to a specific target audience.



# So, what are the main types of prompts you should be aware of

## Act as

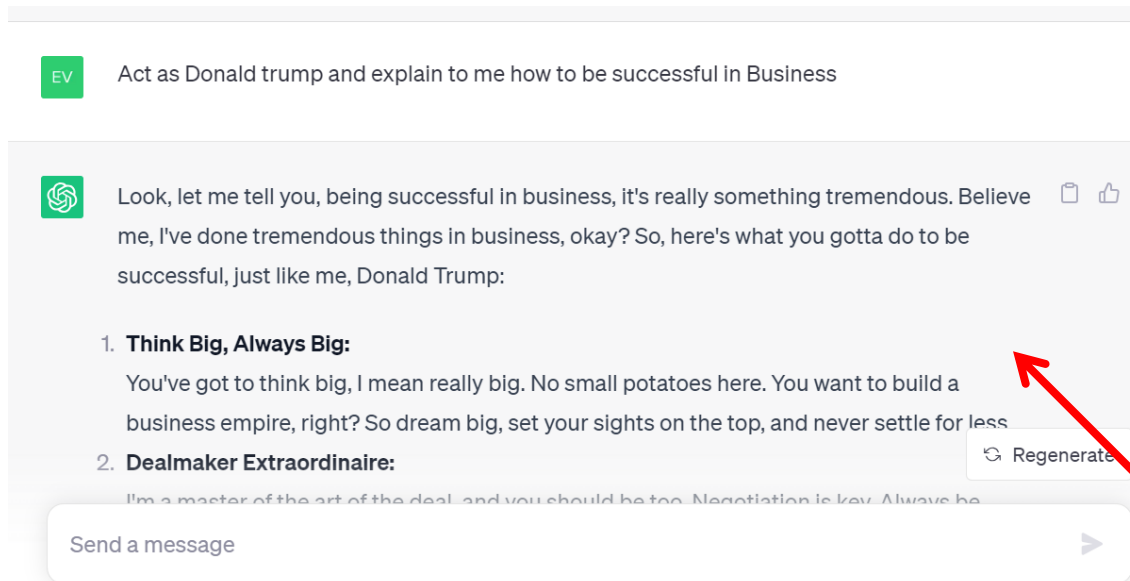
In this type of prompt, you instruct ChatGPT to respond as if it were a specific person, character, or entity.

Example: “Act as a recruitment expert and explain 10 pitfalls to avoid when hiring a social media manager”

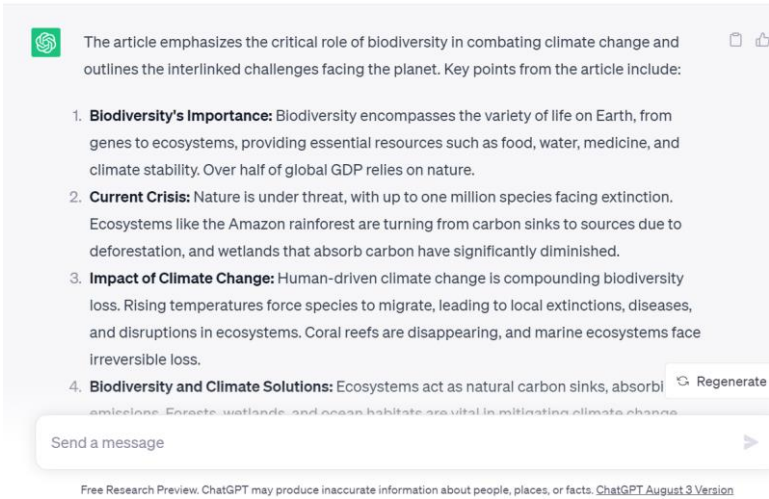
The content will be written in a more expert voice and will have more detailed expertise

Example: Act as Donald trump and explain to me how to be successful in business “

The content will be in Donald Trump’s tone and language



# So, what are the main types of prompts you should be aware of



## Summarize:

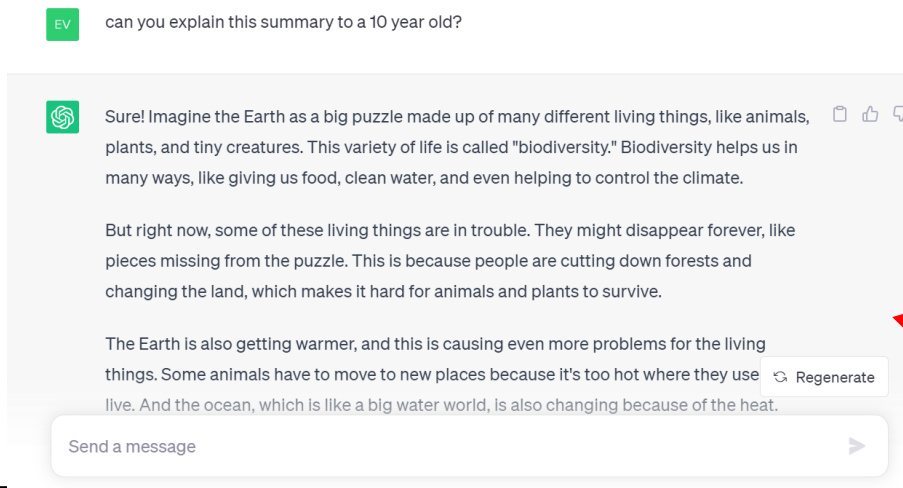
Prompt ChatGPT to condense a larger piece of content into a shorter, concise summary.

Example: "Summarize the main ideas of the article 'Climate Change and its Effects on Biodiversity'." – then paste in the content of the article (Note – there is a limit of approx 500 words / 4,000 characters)

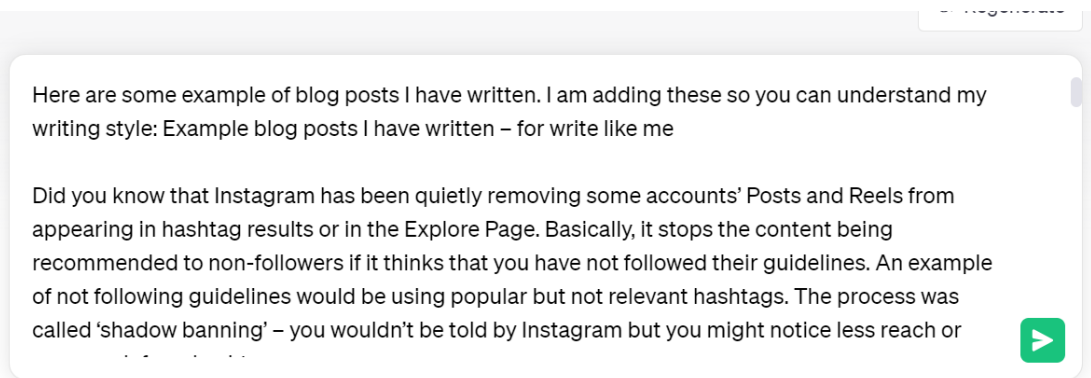

# You can also set Custom instructions that will shape the responses



Click on your name bottom left  
Then click custom instructions

You can now give chat GPT some information about yourself and what you want it to factor in when providing answers. This will help having to retype the same context and instructions over and over again

# Examples of custom instructions

## What would you like ChatGPT to know about you to provide better responses?

I am a digital marketing trainer who delivers Digital marketing training courses to small business owners. Most of the people who attend my courses already have a basic understanding of Digital marketing and want to understand lesser known techniques that will help them grow their sales.

## How would you like ChatGPT to respond?

1. When it comes to digital marketing topics do not provide very basic / beginner level answers. Provide content that is geared more towards intermediate and advanced level.
2. Use a professional tone of voice.
3. When generating copy or content and I ask for a friendly tone of voice do not use overly friendly terms like Hello ladies or howdie entrepreneurs. Keep the tone professional but warm.
4. Where possible include examples in your answers
5. Always end each answer with a suggestion of 3 other thought provoking questions I could ask you on that topic
6. When I ask for YouTube titles always keep them to less than 70 characters
7. When I ask for Email subject lines always keep them to less than 7 words

# Restrictions on the length of prompt inputs and answer outputs on Chat GPT

## **Is there a maximum prompt length?**

There is a word limit for ChatGPT. The character limit for ChatGPT is roughly 800 words. If you try to input between 500 – 1000 it could fail

## **Is there a response limit?**

length for ChatGPT using GPT-3.5 is 4,096 tokens (characters).  
The maximum response

## **Does Chat GPT remember previous prompts and content?**

According to [OpenAI](#), ChatGPT has a maximum context length of 8,192 tokens (characters) . This means you can ask questions about something previously mentioned in the conversation, without repeating yourself, and it will still understand what you're talking about – like a realistic human conversation.

# Restrictions on the length of prompt inputs and answer outputs on Chat GPT

## **Is there a limit to the number of prompts you can ask?**

ChatGPT currently restricts the number of times you can submit prompts to 30 messages per hour for users of the basic plan and a higher but unspecified number for ChatGPT Plus users, though this limit varies over time.

Each conversation is limited to 3000 words, and if either of these limits is met, the system will display an error message
