Very useful editing features to enhance your video

- 1. Permanently remove the CapCut logo
- 2. Add eye catching text using text templates
- 3. Add a sound effect when your text appears / disappears
- 4. Add captions using very eye catching effects

- 7. You can overlay their free stock videos as footage on your video
- 8. You can add some zoom using keyframes

Mobile app Video editor – CapCut





Go to the app store or play store on your phone. Search for and download CapCut

Over 400 million people use Inshot

It is made by Bytedance - the same company that owns TikTok so there is a lot of integration with TikTok

You can use the app for free and there won't be a watermark on your video

However, they have lots of Pro features and to use those you would need to buy a license


Inshot is a brilliant video editing app and there is a full course showing you to use it on the members website


Inshot has everything you need to make very high quality marketing videos

But If you want to use it for free, there will be a watermark on your video.

However, the cost of a license is very reasonable. You could buy a lifetime license for \$40

Why use CapCut instead of Inshot?





The main benefits of CapCut:

- You can use it for free and there won't be a watermark. You can do for free most of what you can do on Inshot
- They have better free captions and better free text effects than Inshot
- They have extra free features like video templates and Teleprompter, Stock video library that Inshot doesn't have

Plus .. In the Pro version they also have some very eye catching and advanced effects that look way better than Inshot

However, the Pro version of CapCut is more expensive than an Inshot license

What are the 4 main types of marketing videos



There are 4 big types of marketing videos

- 1. Testimonials
- 2. Company promo
- 3. Product / service videos
- 4. "How to" videos

Testimonial and Company promo videos are typically made with someone being Interviewed

Product or service videos typically have someone speaking directly to camera

"How To" videos typically have someone speaking to camera

Landscape or vertical? Ask yourself, why are you creating the video



Is it a "marketing" video created to showcase your business, product, service?

- Examples would be company promo, testimonial, 60 second product or service video
- You would want to have these videos on your website and YouTube ... And also post them on Facebook, LinkedIn and Twitter

Landscape or vertical? Ask yourself, why are you creating the video.

Example of a landscape video



Any important "marketing" videos like these should be shot and edited landscape because that works best on your website and YouTube.

Plus landscape works well on Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn

Example of a portrait video



Ask yourself, why are you creating the video?



Is it a "social media" video created primarily to be a social media post?

- Examples would be "How to" videos, helpful tips, short videos about a product or promotion, short video about an event or behind the scenes with staff.
- You are really creating this video to post it on Facebook, Instagram, LinkedIn and Twitter and having it on your website is not that important

If this is the case, you need to ask yourself, which is your most important social network – the one you get most reach and engagement on – and then decide the format based on what works best on that social network

If it is Instagram you should make a Reel which is vertical video





How to get started editing a video



- When you open the app this is your main menu.
- Note that there are options at the top. You can choose one of these options before entering the editor if you wish. E.g. – you want to add captions or use the teleprompter.
- Note tap the dropdown arrow to display more
- At the bottom you have an option to use their premade templates
- To edit a video simply tap on New Project



How to get started editing a video



- You can now choose videos from your phone
- Note you can also browse through their free stock video and free stock image library
- To get to an album on your phone tap the dropdown next to album
- When you find the album, select the clips that you want.
 Tap HD to use the HD version of the clip







- Open the app
- Tap New project
- Find the album on your phone
- Select the clip you want to start the video with
- Tap HD
 Tap Add
- Your clip is now on the timeline
- Tap play and pause to choose the part where you want to split the clip
- To get the split option either tap edit or tap on the clip







- Tap split
- Then select the part you want to delete
- Then tap on delete
 - Then Tap on + in order to add the next clip.
- Select the clip and then repeat the process of splitting and deleting the part you don't want.
- Keep repeating until you have added and edited all your clips

Remove the CapCut logo clip at the end

 At the end of your video there will be the CapCut logo. To delete this simply tap on the clip and then tap delete







To reduce the volume of your clips

Tap on a clip
Then tap volume

Reduce the volume by dragging the slider to the left

To reduce the volume of other clips simply tap on another clip at this stage and you can drag the slider







To add a voice over

Tap on audio in the bottom menu

Then tap record


Then speak into the phone. (You will get a better result if you use a microphone)








To add a voice over


Your voiceover will now be added to the timeline below your video

















To add music

Slide to the end of your video and you will see that the music is longer than your video

Position the line at the point you want to cut the music

Then tap split and delete the part you don't want

You should now fade out the music

Tap fade and fade out for around 2.5 sec






To export your video

Tap the arrow in the top right of the screen

Your video will export

It will be placed in your camera folder





- Open the app
- Tap New project
- Find the album on your phone
- Select the clip you want to start the video with
- Tap HD
- Tap Add





- Your clip is now on the timeline
- Tap play and pause to choose the part where you want to split the clip
- To get the split option either tap edit or tap on the clip






- Tap split
- Then select the part you want to delete
- Then tap on delete

Then go to the end of your video and if there is something you want to cut out, pause at the end of the part you want to keep and then split and delete the part you don't want

Remove the CapCut logo clip at the end

 At the end of your video will be the CapCut logo. To delete this simply tap on the clip and then tap delete





To crop into the video or crop parts out CapCut

Select the shape of your video e.g., 9:16

Then drag the corner of the video to choose the crop you want

Then tap on the tick



To overlay footage on top of your video


Play and then pause at the point where you would like to overlay footage

Tap on Overlay in the bottom menu

Find the footage / video that you want to overlay. Tap to select

Tap HD and then add





To overlay footage on top of your video

The video now appears on top of your main video.

You can pinch it with 2 fingers to expand it to completely cover the main video


On the timeline the video appears below the main video


Press play and pause where you want the footage to end


Tap on the footage clip on the timeline


Then tap split and delete


Repeat this process for other footage clips you want to add














To export your video



Permanently remove the CapCut logo




Whenever you create a video CapCut will place the CapCut logo at the end of your video

You can permanently turn this off so it won't add it for future videos

When you open the app, tap on settings icon top right


Next to Add default ending toggle to switch this off






Add eye catching text using text templates




- Tap on Text in the bottom menu
- If you tap on Add text you can type your text, choose font, colour etc.
- But if you tap on Text templates, you can choose from lots of very eye catching text combinations




Add eye catching text using text templates




- They have different categories of templates – trending, social media etc
- Tap one and it will appear on your video
- Tap a word to then edit the text
- You can then choose where you want it to start and end on your video




Add a sound effect when your text appears



- You could add sound effects.
 For example you could have a whoosh sound when your text appears on the screen
- Tap on Audio
- Search though sounds for whoosh
- Choose one and add to your video
- The sound will then be added to the timeline
- You can then position the sound on the timeline to line up with the text appearing



Add captions using very eye catching effects




- Tap on text in the bottom menu
- Then tap on auto captions
- Then browse though the captions effects
- Then tap on generate


The captions will then appear on the timeline

Tap on any of the boxed and you can correct the text. You can also adjust the size, font, font colour

Tap on Batch edit and you can see all of the text boxes for easy editing




Add bilingual captions



- You can have a second set of captions appear in a different language
- Tap Bilingual captions
 - Choose the language e.g. Spanish
- Tap generate
- The second set of captions will then appear below the first


Add transitions between clips




- You can add transition effects between 2 videos
- Tap the line in between the clips

Then choose a transition effect. You will see a preview of how it looks

- You can also adjust the time length to make the effect last longer or shorter
- You can apply to all clips is you want.



You can overlay their free stock videos as footage on your video



To overlay stock videos on top of your video tap on overlay in the bottom menu

On the top right tap stock videos

You can then search for the type of video you want


You can also choose whether you want videos or images to do with that topic

Select your video


Tap HD

Then add

Then pinch to make your video fill the screen as per previous lesson



You can add some zoom using keyframes




To add zoom you can use Keyframes

Stop at the point where you would like to start some zoom. The tap on the diamond icon to drop a keyframe


Ther go to the point where you would like the zoom to stop. Add another keyframe and then split your clip.

With 2 fingers pinch the video to zoom in the point where you want maximum zoom

Now when you play the clip it will gently zoom in between keyframe 1 and keyframe 2




You can remove the background of your video




- Tap on your clip in the timeline
- In the bottom menu tap on remove BG
- Then tap auto removal

The background is now removed


Try doing this when you overlay a video of someone speaking on top of another video or image. The background for the person will not be the main video or image




You can retouch (improve the look) of the person speaking




- Tap on a clip on the timeline
- Then tap on retouch
- Then decide if you want to retouch the persons face or body
- When you choose face or body then brose though the various retouching you can do
- When you find one you like you then apply to all clips




You can add effects to the person speaking




In the bottom menu tap on effects
 Then tap body effects




You can add effects to the person speaking



- Browse though the various
 categories of effects
- Tap an effect and it will preview it



Try video templates



There are lots of video templates you can try

In the main screen when you open the app tap on templates in the bottom menu

Browse through the different categories.

Tap on a template to view it

Tap use template in order to select your files which will then be added to the template
