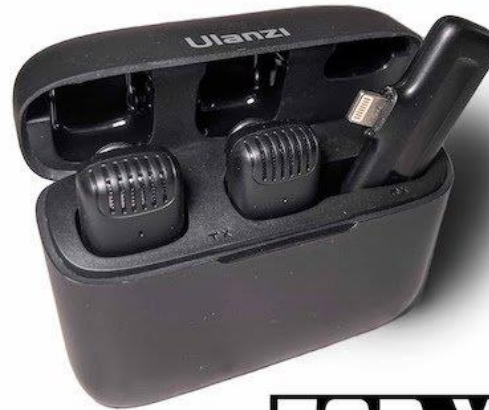

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Examples of thumbnails



Why do you need a thumbnail?

- It is what tempts people to click play on your video on your website.
- It appears in YouTube and Facebook search results
- A typical CTR is 2-4 % and a good thumbnail can improve that.

A good thumbnail should be

- Eye Catching / Colourful
- Immediately legible
- Conveys what the video is about

Examples of thumbnails

2. A screenshot from the video with text?



How to design a thumbnail



In Canva.com or Canva app you can

1. Choose from predesigned thumbnails and change their image for yours and the text to yours.
2. Or design a thumbnail from scratch based on your image and text

You could create a thumbnail like this



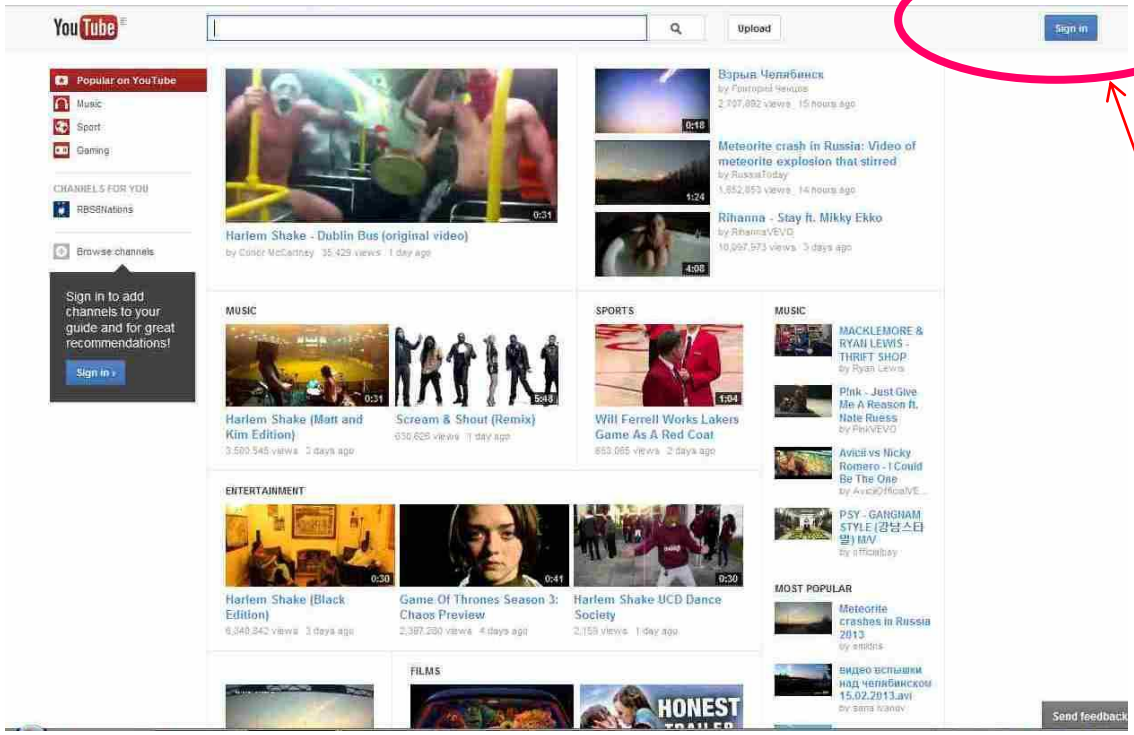
1. Take a screenshot of your video
2. In Canva, select the option for YouTube thumbnail video
3. Upload your screenshot
4. Add it to the canvas
5. Under elements search for 5 star and click graphics. Choose your graphic
6. Under elements search for reviews then click graphics. Choose your graphic
7. On the left click text, choose heading and then add your text.

You could create a thumbnail like this



1. Take a screenshot of your video
2. In Canva, select the option for thumbnail video
3. Upload your screenshot
4. Add it to the canvas
5. Under elements choose shapes and select a rectangle shape to add to your image
6. Change the colour of the shape
7. Add transparency
8. Add text

How to create a YouTube account

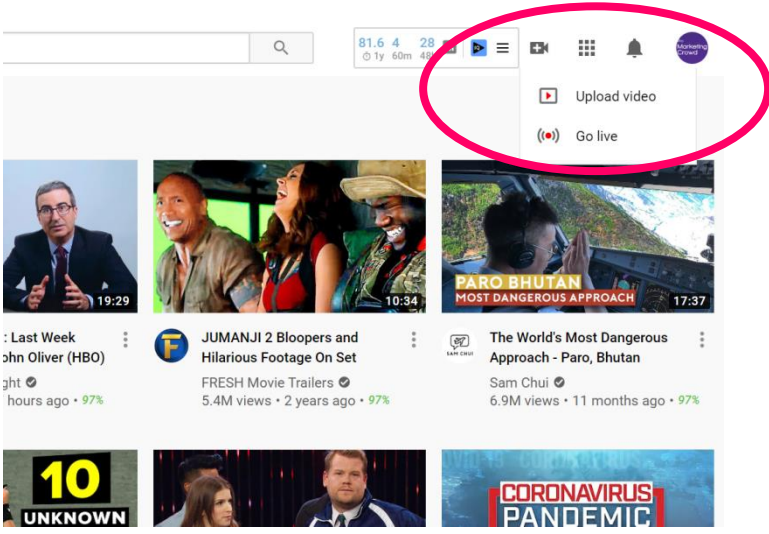


You need an account

1. To upload your own videos
2. To interact with videos (comment etc)
3. To interact with other members of YouTube

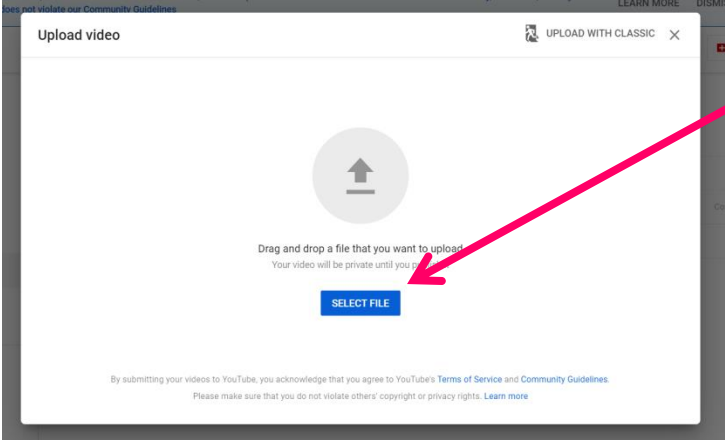

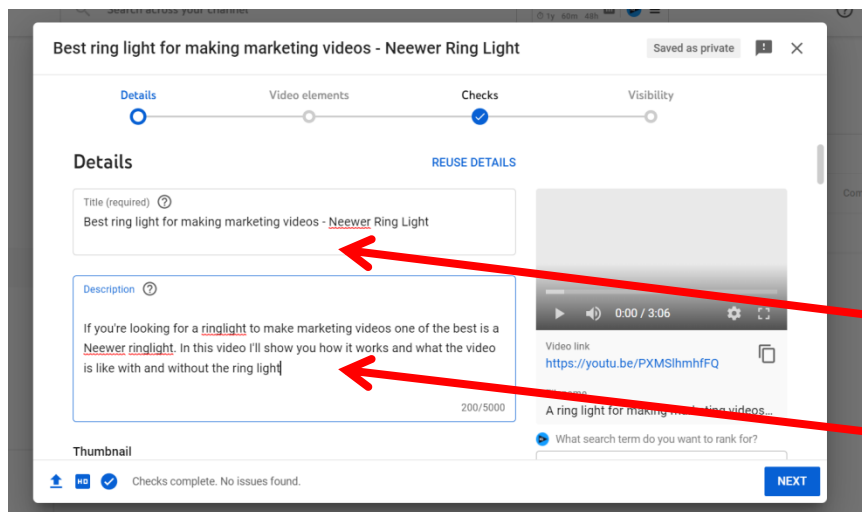
To upload a video tap on the + symbol

And then Upload Video

Click on Select File and choose the video form your PC. It will then start uploading



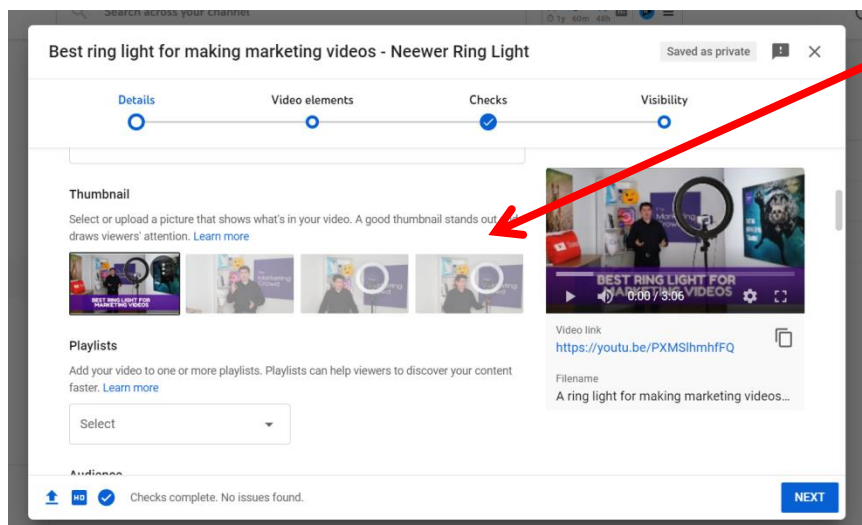
Change the title of the video to a title that people are likely to search for. Include the name of your business in the title.



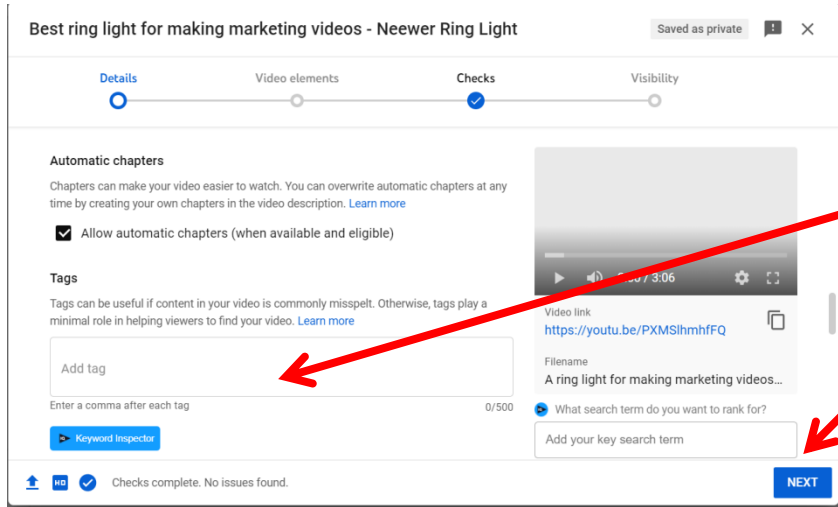
Uploading A Video

When you select a video from your hard drive you then see this screen. You can ...

- Change the title of the video to something people are likely to search for.
- Add a description
- Choose a thumbnail or add the custom thumbnail that you designed
- Add tags which help gets your video found

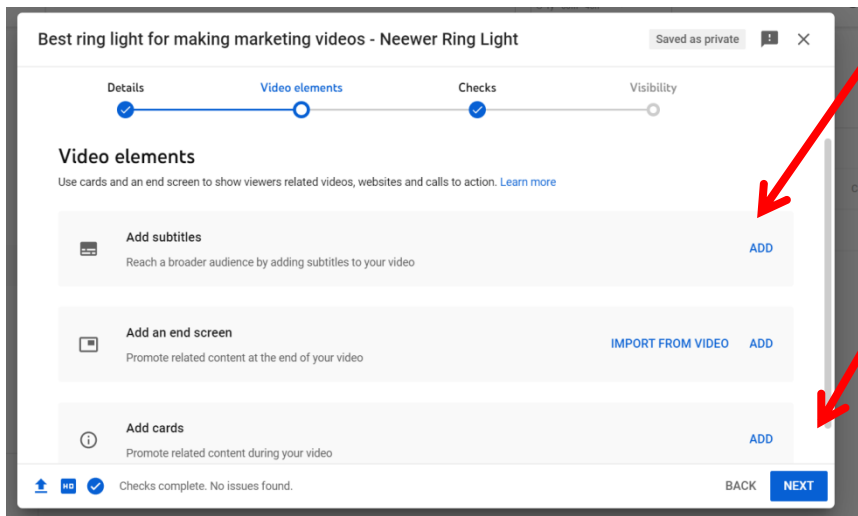

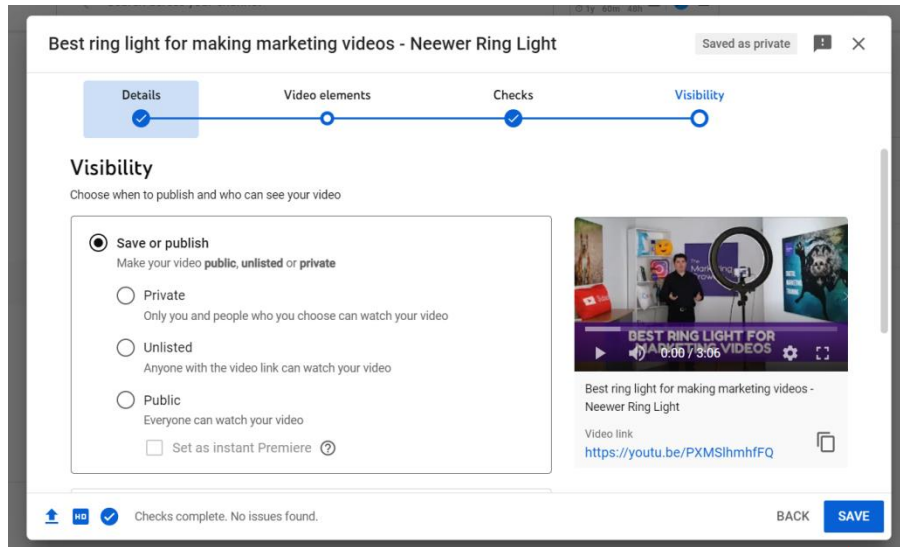


Uploading A Video

- Add tags which help gets your video found
- Click next to proceed
- Click of you want to manually add captions. Otherwise, YouTube will automatically generate them
- Click next

Uploading A Video

Decide on the visibility for your video

Public – you want your marketing videos to be public. They will be found in search and suggested as relevant videos.

Unlisted – handy if you want to keep your video away from search results and suggestions. E.g. if you want to show a colleague a draft of your video.

Private – you will need to indicate which Gmail account you want to give access to. Only someone logged in with that Gmail can watch it.

How to embed a video on a web page

- Log into the back end of your website and go to the page that you want to add the video to
- Ensure you switch to Text mode (or HTML mode – depending on your editor)
- Paste the code in
- Then update your page
- Your video will now appear on the page

If you are shooting marketing videos indoors an excellent affordable light is a Neewer 18 inch Ring light. In this short video I'll show you why light and also without the light.
If you can buy the light locally please shop local but if you can't find it locally you can get it on Amazon for around €80 – here is a link <https://www.amazon.com/dp/B078888888>
Definitely worth getting this if you make marketing videos



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What if your video is the wrong shape for a social network?



If you are selling to consumers or small businesses, I think Instagram will be your most important because it gives you the most reach

Within Instagram, Reels gives you the most reach, e.g. 30 – 50% reach compared to 17% with posts and 7% with stories

1. Record and edit your videos portrait and post as a Reel and also as a Story
2. Then convert the video into a square video using Canva and post this LinkedIn. Square looks great on those networks

Note: Choose a frame in Canva and place the video in a frame

What if your video is the wrong shape for a social network?



If you are selling to business professionals and you feel LinkedIn is your most important social Network

1. Record your video landscape and share it on LinkedIn as landscape
2. You should not share this landscape video as a Reel – it won't look good.
3. Instead you could then use Canva to place the video on a portrait background (use a frame to make it look very interesting) and turn that into a video for Reels and Instagram Stories

Note: Choose a frame in Canva and place the video in a frame

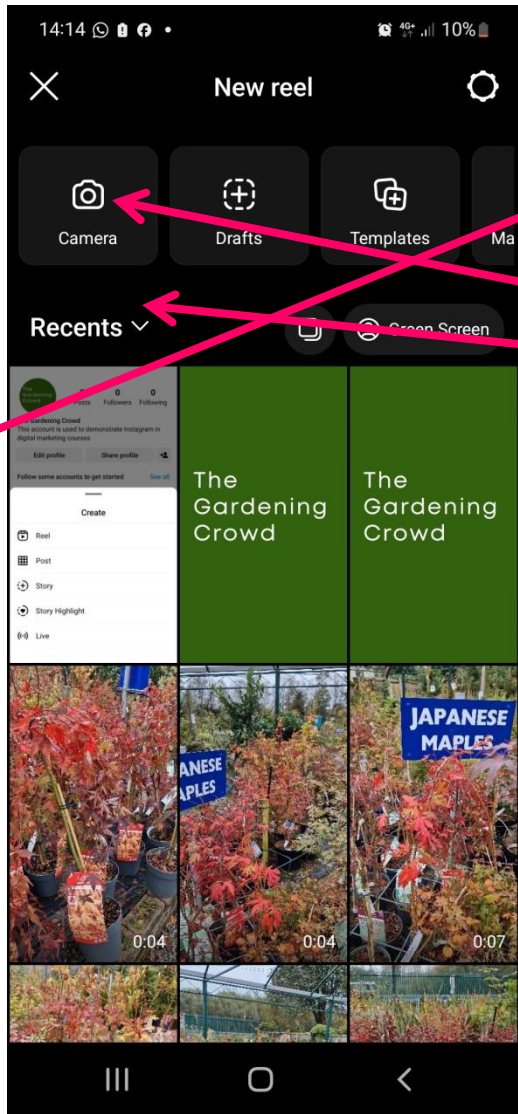
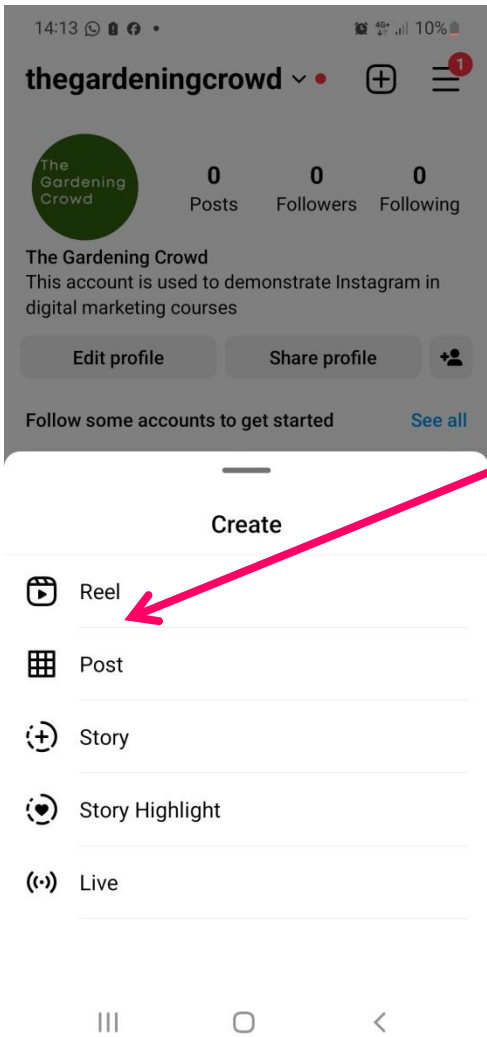
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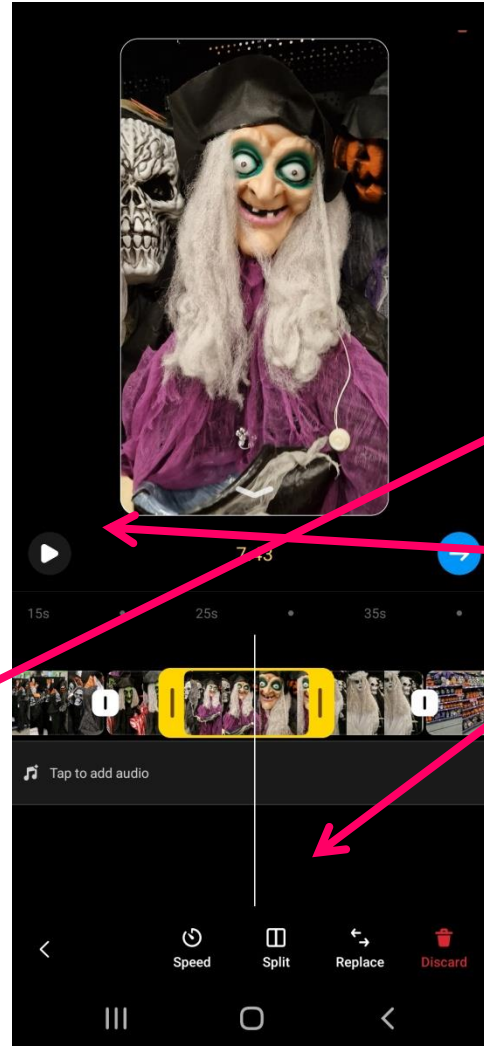
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How to create a Reel using video footage, music and text



- How to create a Reel**
1. Go to your profile and tap +
 2. Then tap on Reel
 3. Tap on camera if you want to take a video right now
 4. Tap the arrow next to Recents to find video from your phone

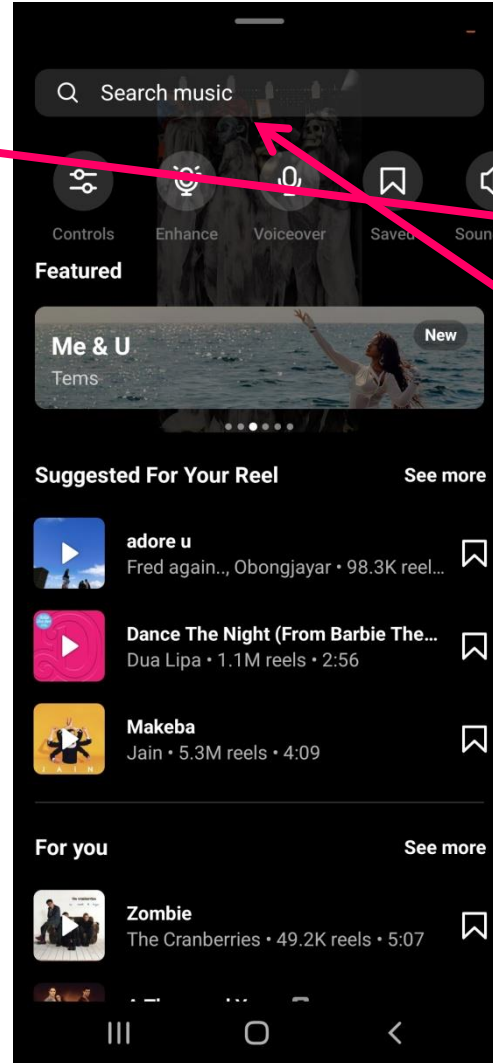
How to create a Reel

You are now in the area where you can edit the clips, add text, effects stickers add music etc.

Tap on the edit button to edit your video clips

Press play / pause and then split your clips where you want to cut them. Tap discard to delete

8. To add music tap on the music symbol

You can then search for music or go to your saved music

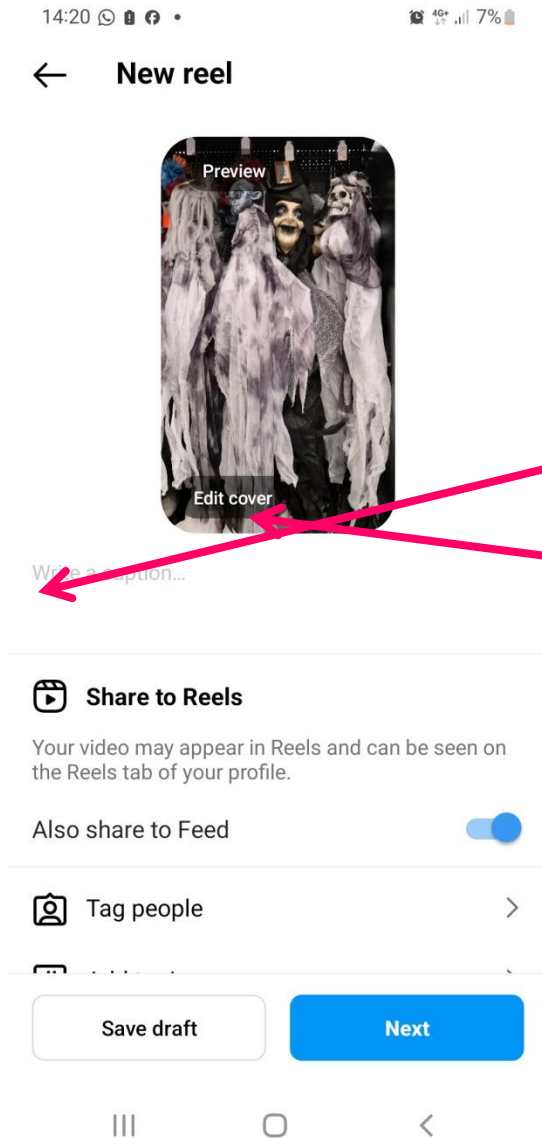

How to create a Reel

- 9 – Tap Aa to add text. When you add text you can then edit the amount of time it is on the video in the editor
10. Tap the sticker icon to add stickers. Eg. search for words like Sale or Wow or Spooky
11. Tap the 3 stars to search for and add effects

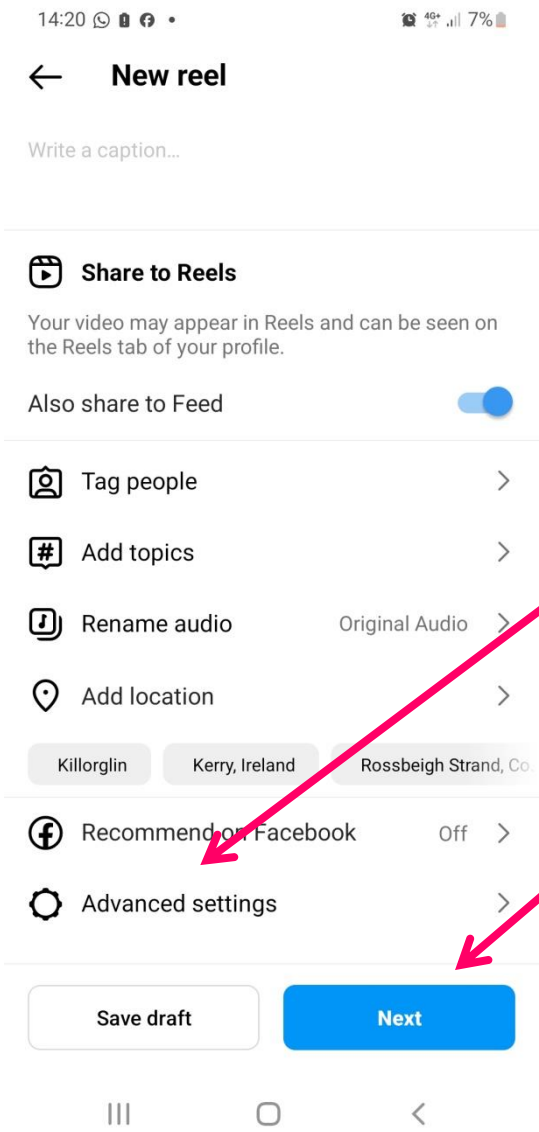
How to create a Reel

Write a caption (text) that goes out with your Reel

Also add hashtags – these will help your reel get discovered by non followers

Tap edit cover to choose a part of the Reel to be the image that represents your Reel in the profile grid

Tap Advanced and you should have the option to schedule your Reel

Tap share to send out your Reel

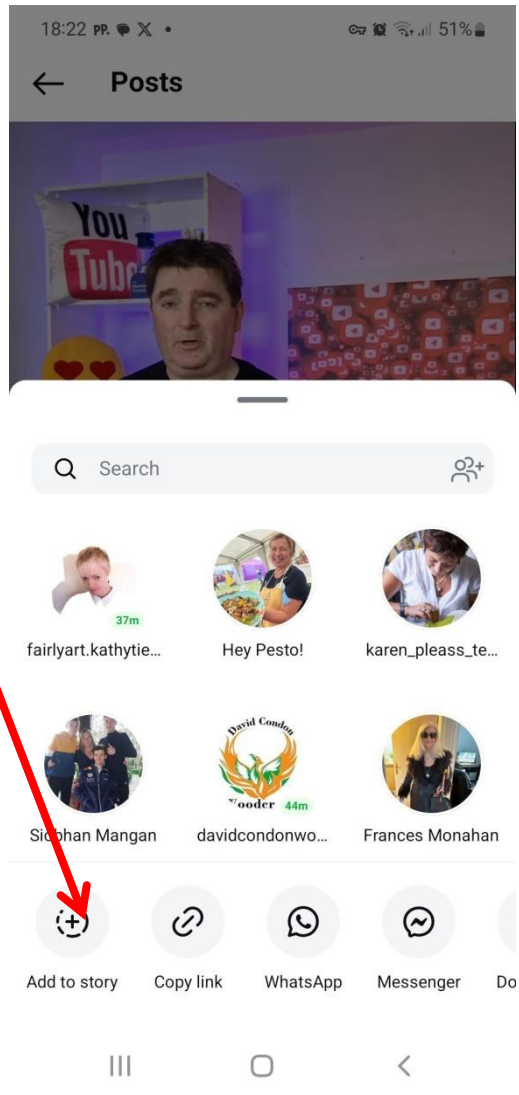

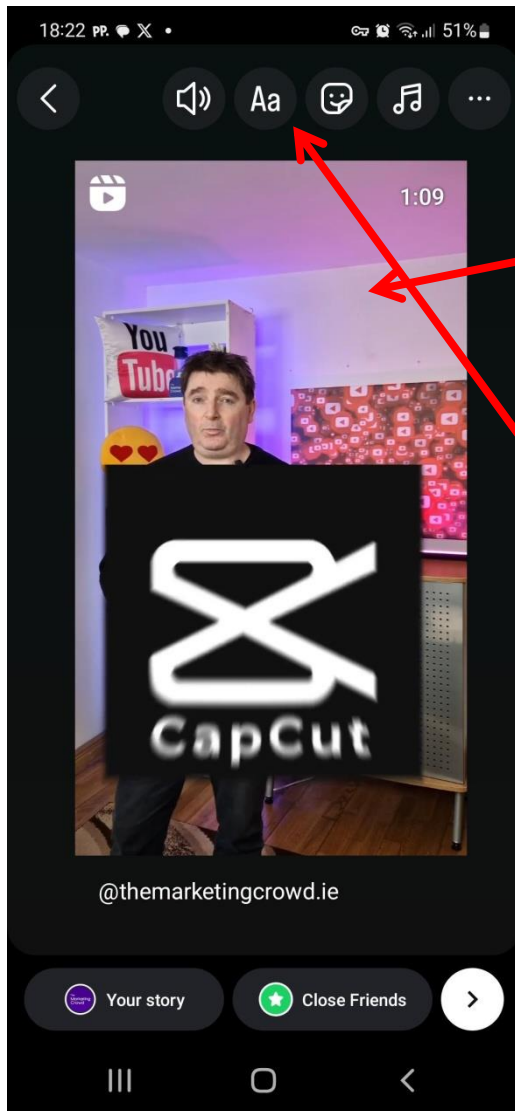

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About Facebook Reels

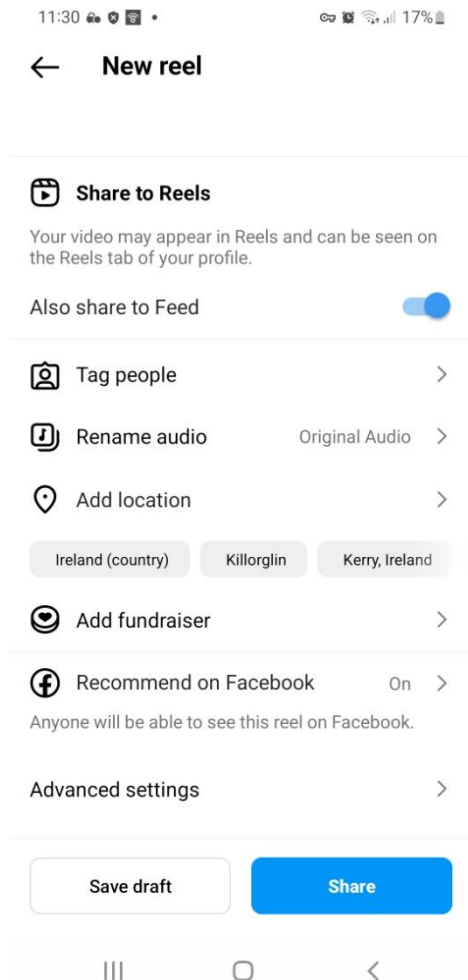


Facebook introduced Reels in 2022

Note – you can only create Facebook Reels on the Facebook app

There are a lot of similarities with Instagram Reels but also some differences.

Can you share Instagram Reels to Facebook?



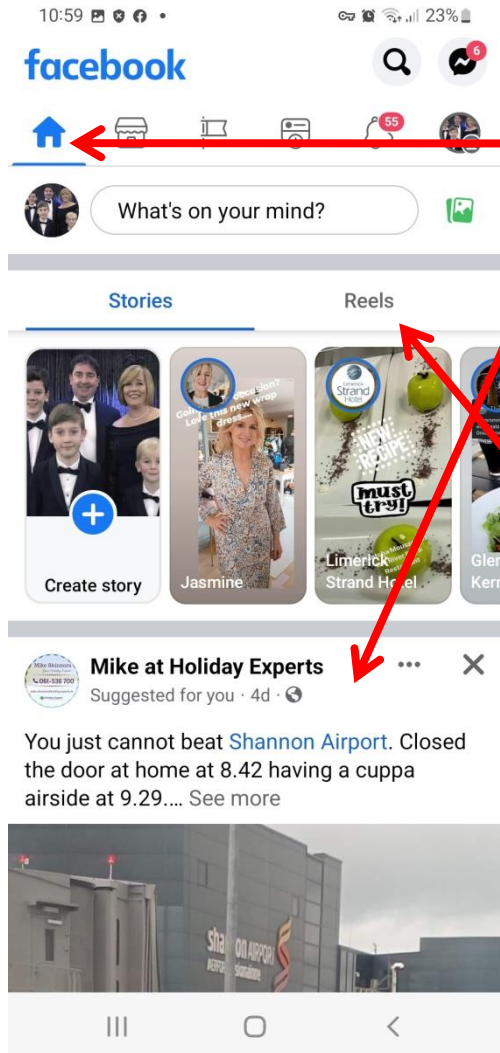
Currently, you cannot share Reel to Facebook in order it to go into the feeds of your page followers. However, this is going to change.

Currently, when you are creating an Instagram Reel you have the option to “recommend” on Facebook

Make sure you switch this on. This means that your Reel can appear in the Reels feed of non followers.

In order to easily share your Instagram Reel on Facebook you should save your Instagram Reel and then Post it as a new reel on Facebook.

Where do they appear?

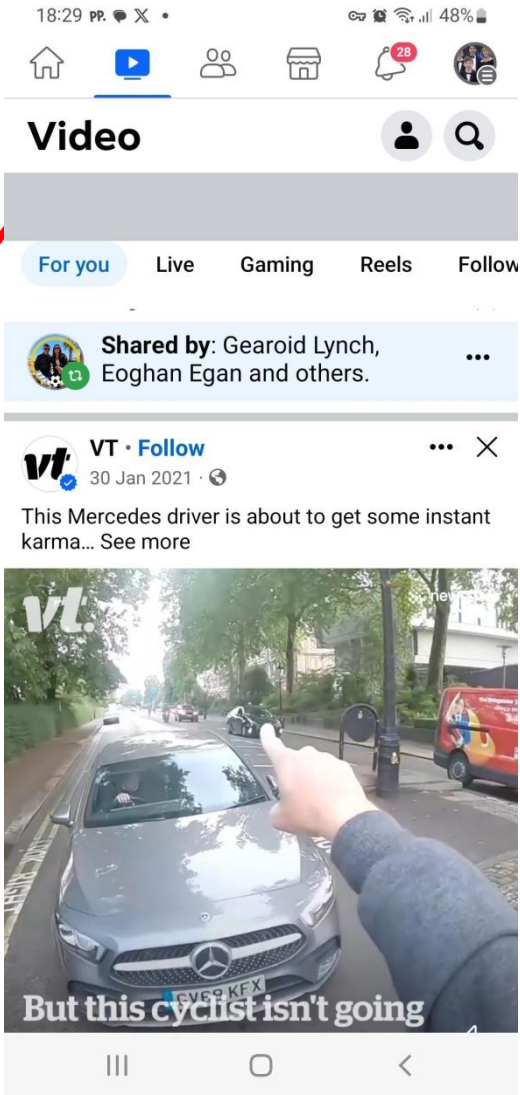


When you open the Facebook app you are taken to your Feed.

This feed contains posts and Reels from friends and accounts you are following

However, there is also a separate Reels feed.

When you tap on Video icon you are taken to video feeds. Then tap on Reels and this is the Reels feed

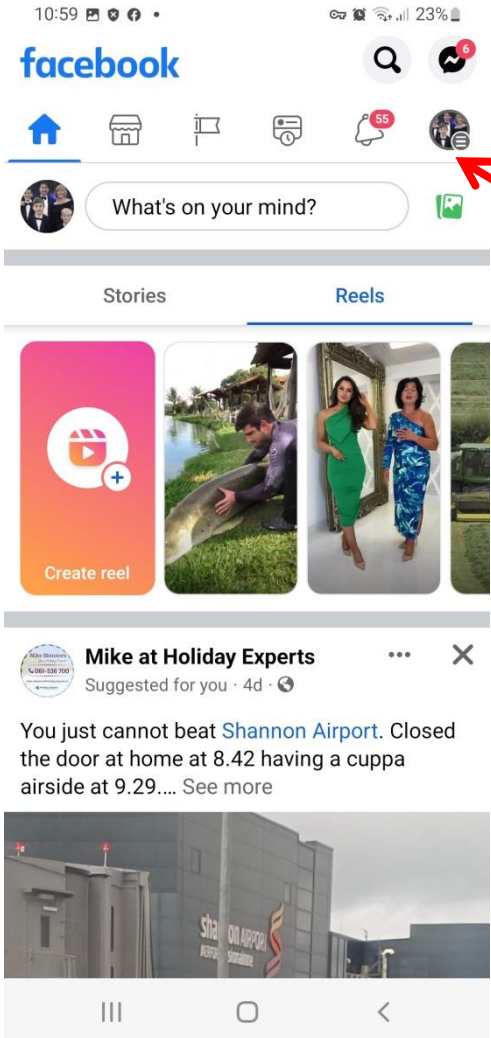

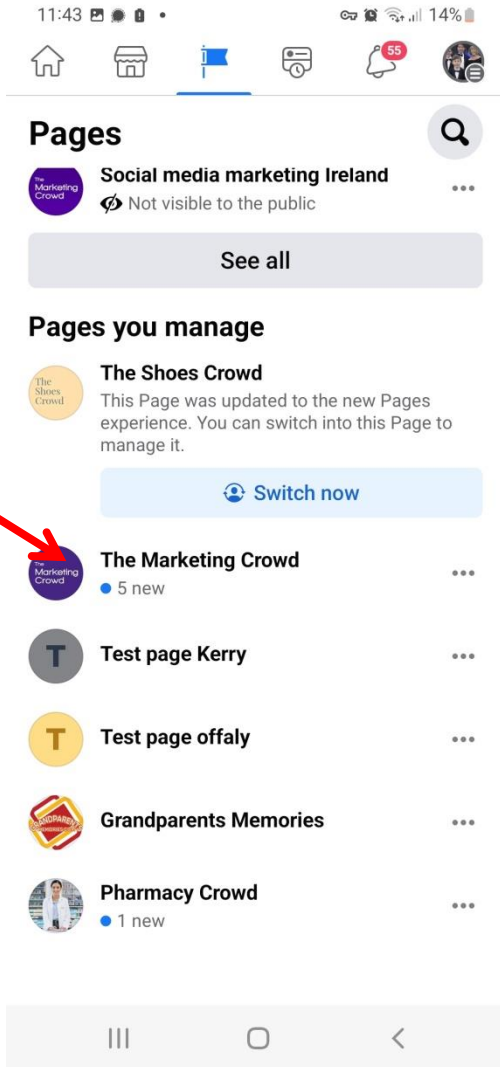

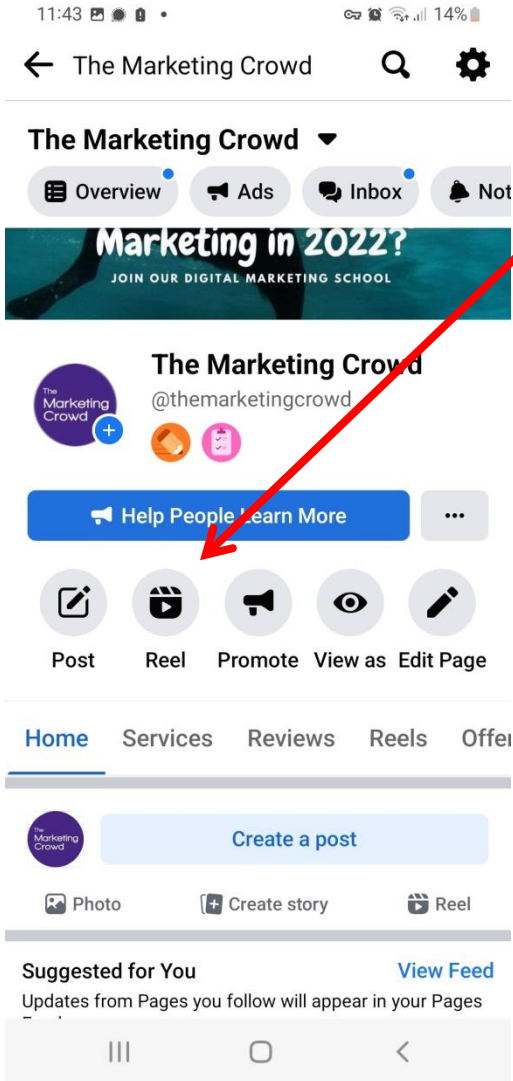
Open the Facebook app

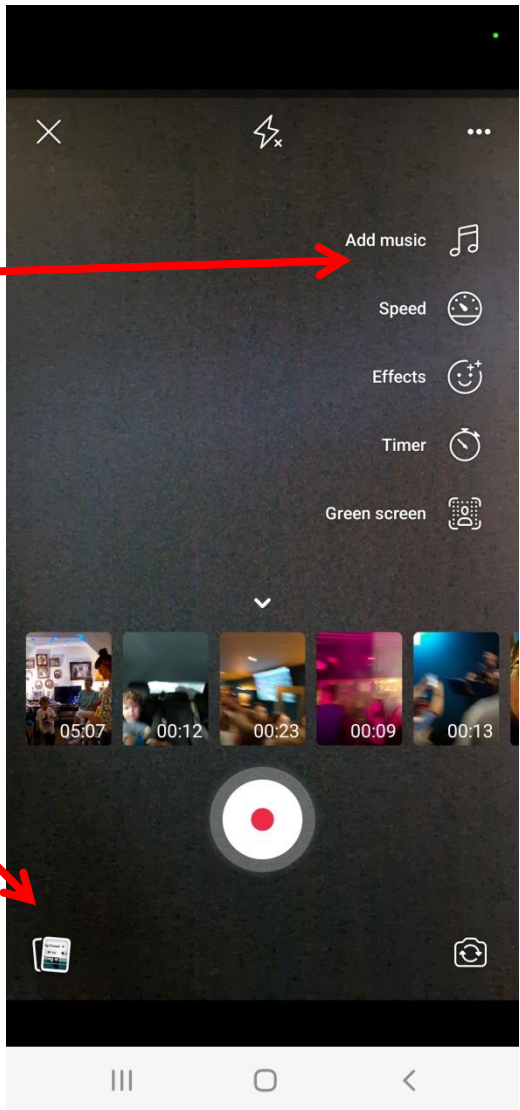
To create a Reel tap Reel

You can now choose music

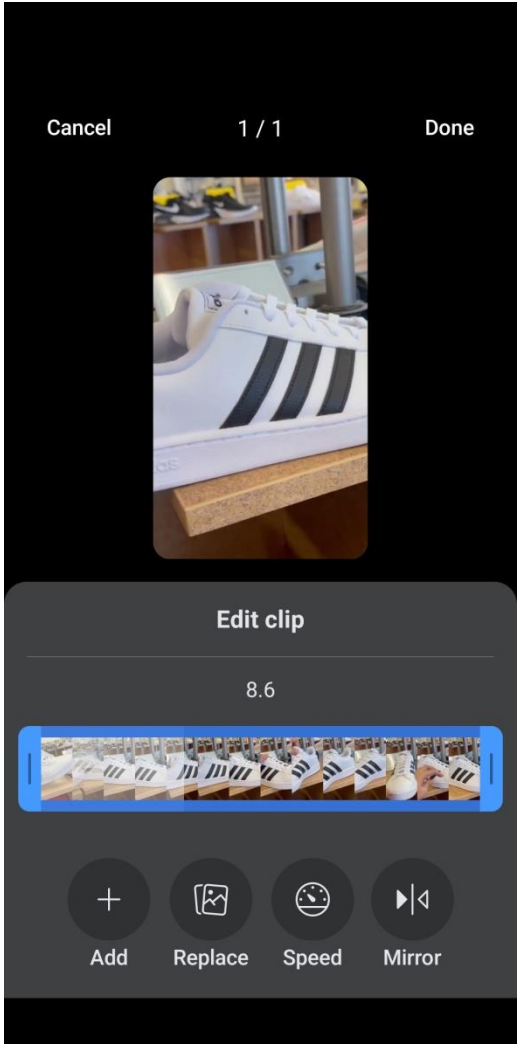
Note – business pages on Facebook get the good music library

Reels are up to 60 seconds long on Facebook

Tap the icon bottom left to choose video clips from your phone

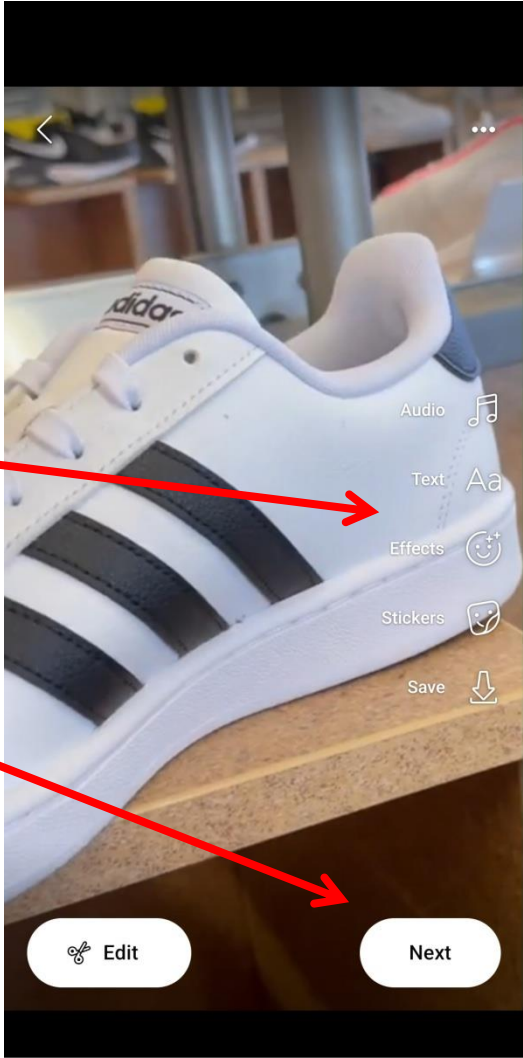
You can choose multiple clips

You can also edit the clips – very similar to Instagram

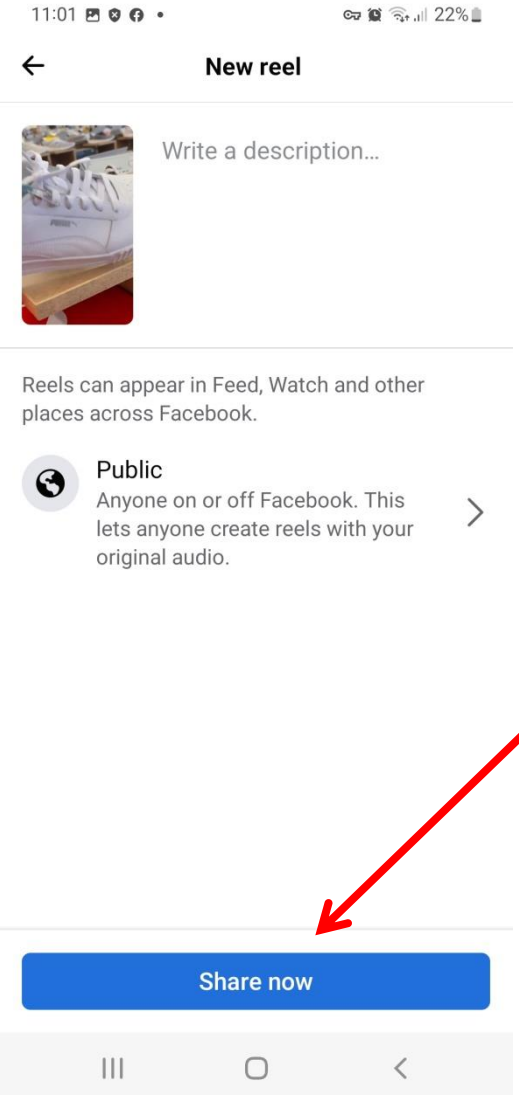
You can add or change music at this stage

You can add text and add stickers / effects

Tap next to proceed

You then add a description / hashtags

However, you cannot add a cover

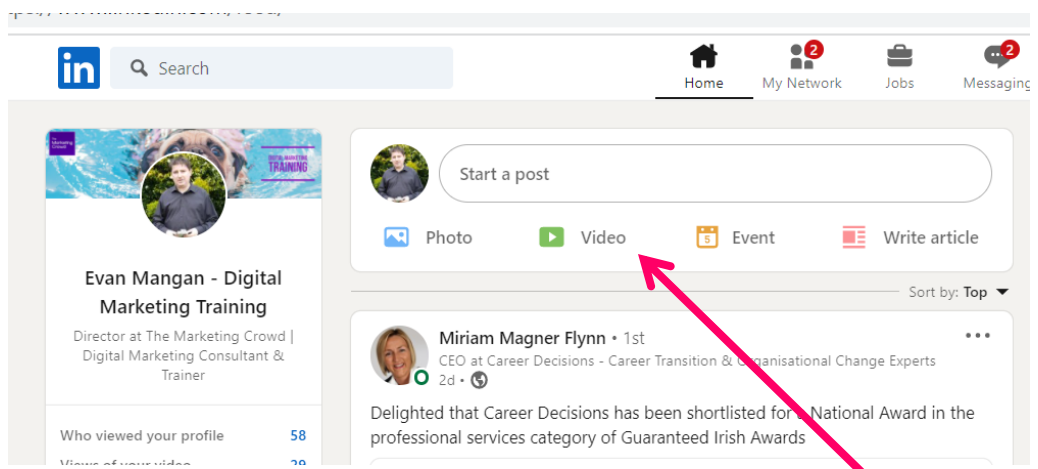

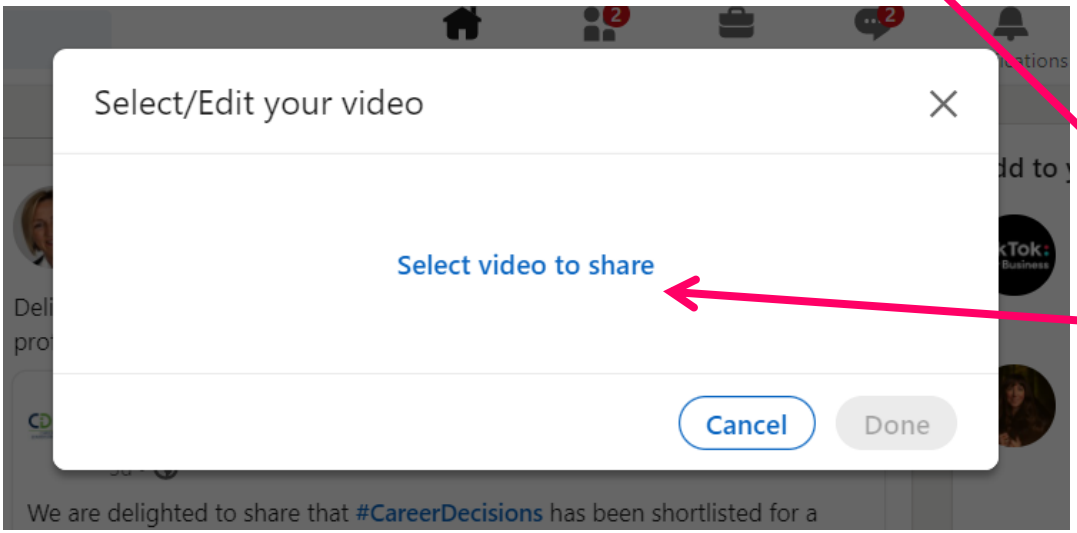


You can post videos up to 10 mins long on LinkedIn

Landscape videos 16:9 or square videos work best

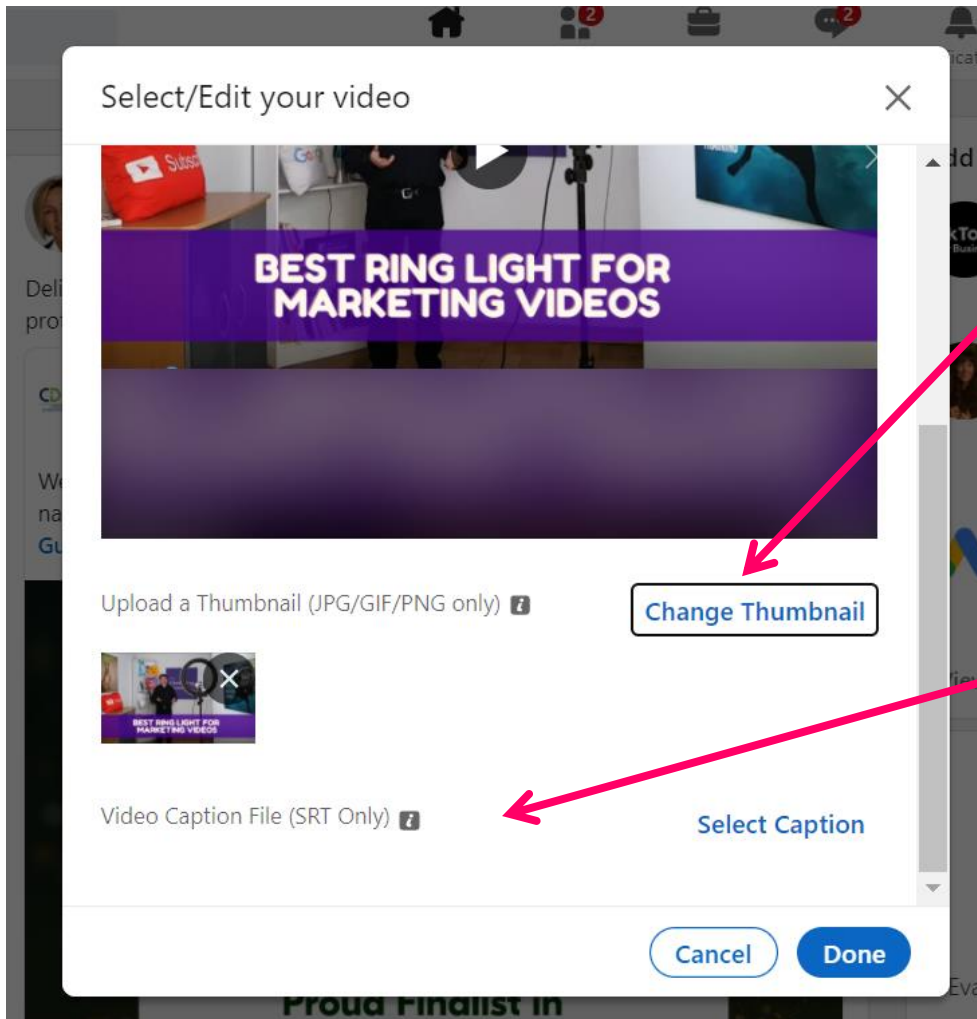
You can post vertical videos but not all of it is visible when it appears in people's newsfeeds.

2. In the section where you create a post, click video
3. Select a video from your PC

How to post your video using LinkedIn.com website



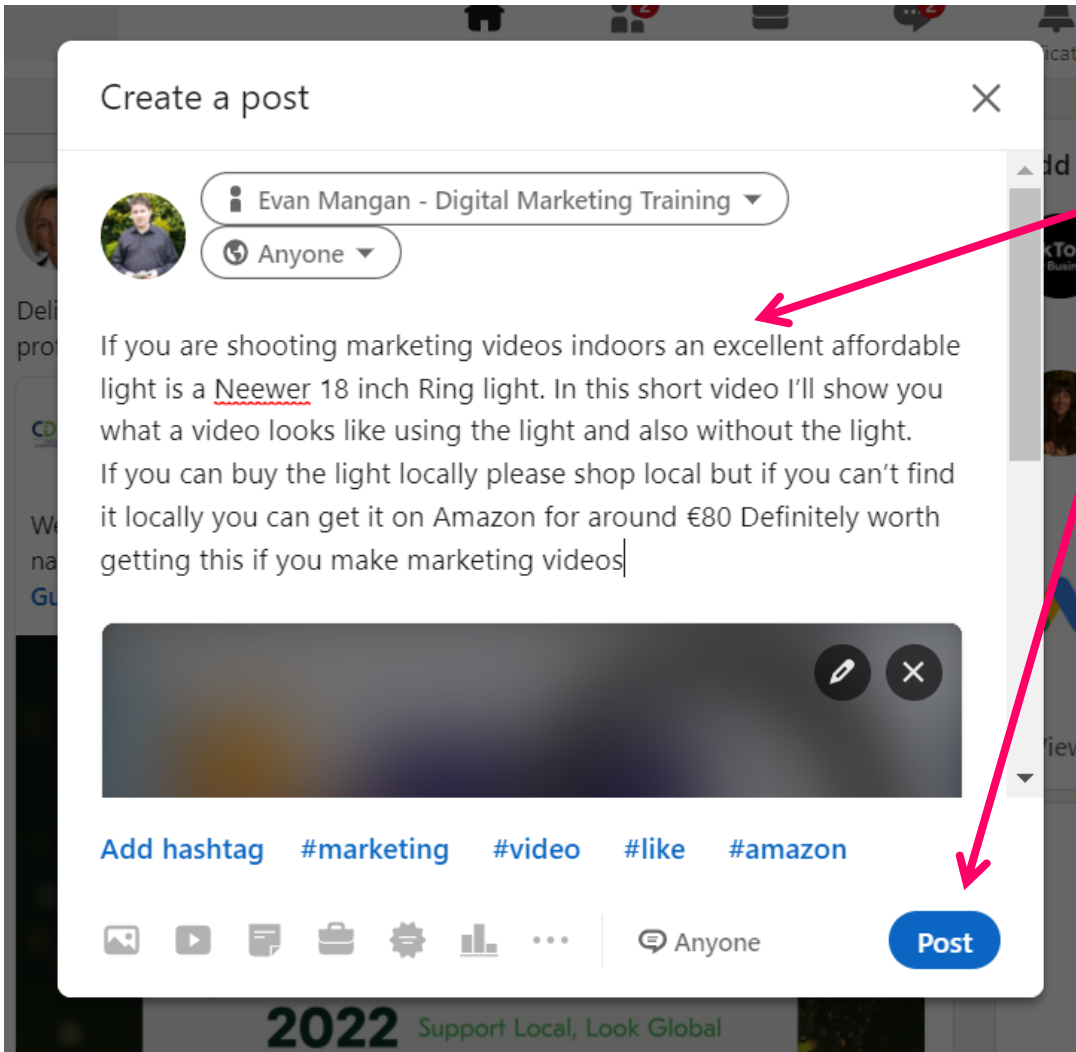
You can now also upload your thumbnail.

Design your thumbnail using Canva

LinkedIn does not auto generate captions so you are best to use a service like quicc.io

LinkedIn gives the option to upload an SRT file – this is a formatted file which has the captions prewritten.

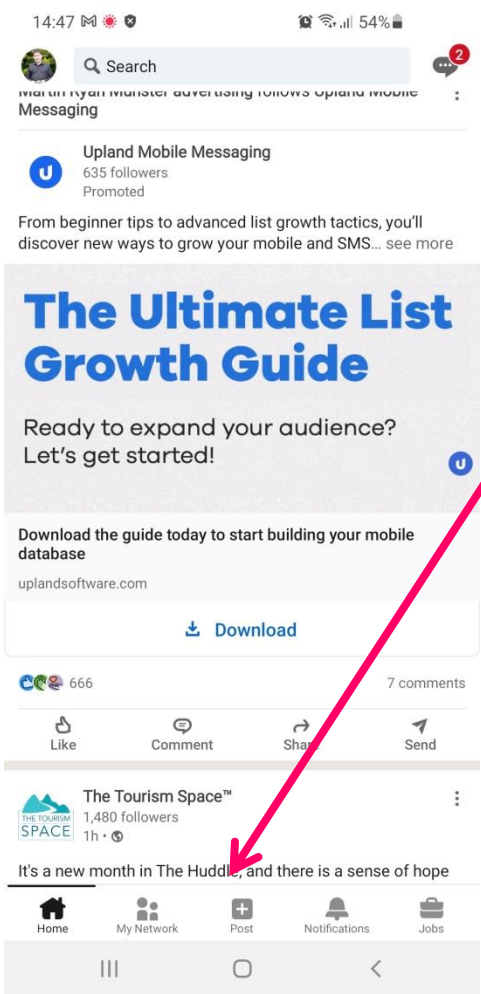

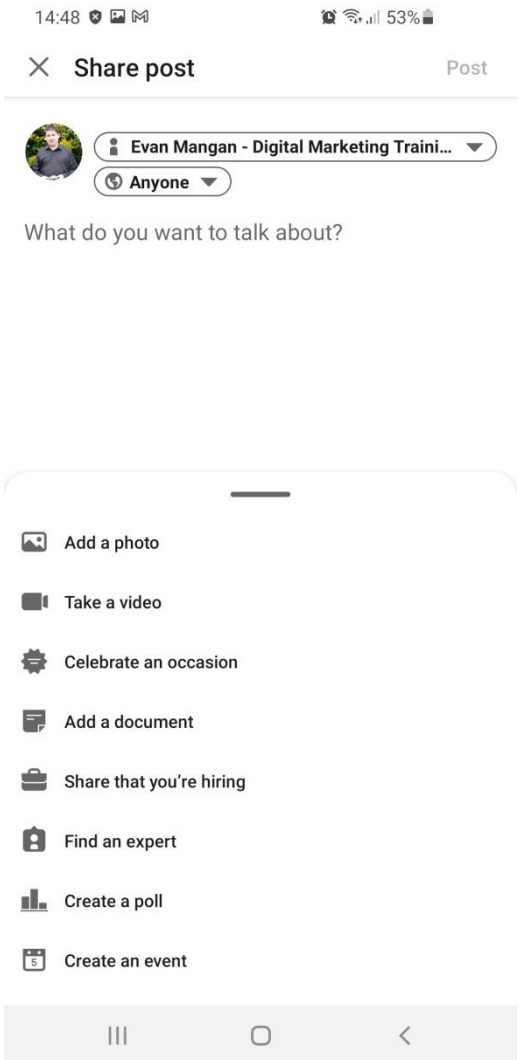

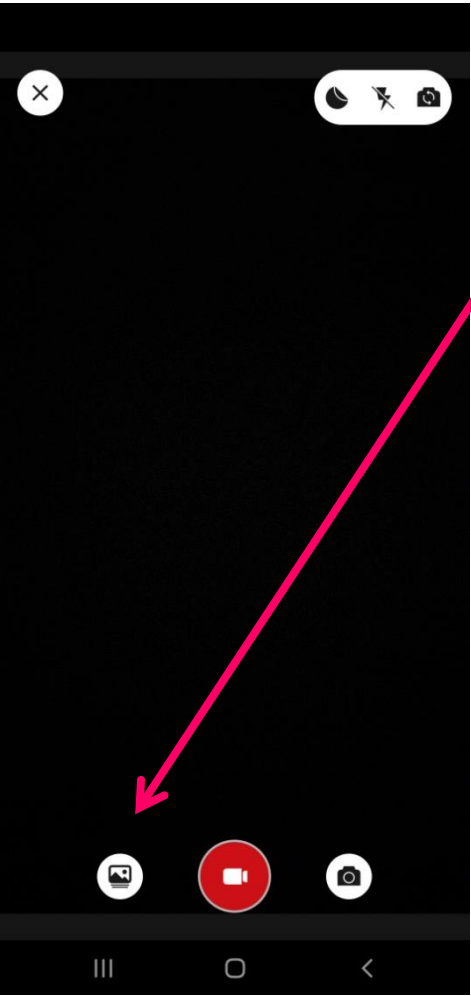
Open the LinkedIn app and ensure you are logged in

Then tap on Take a video



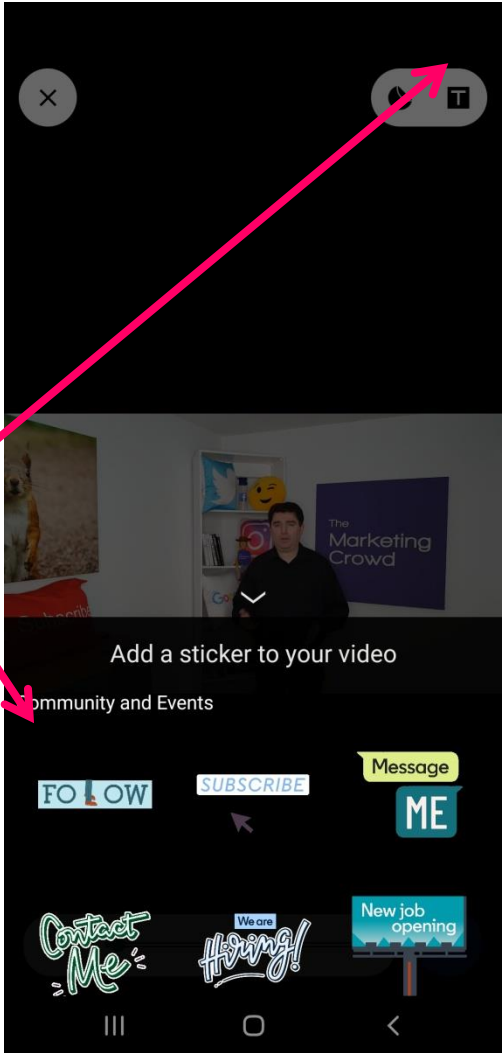

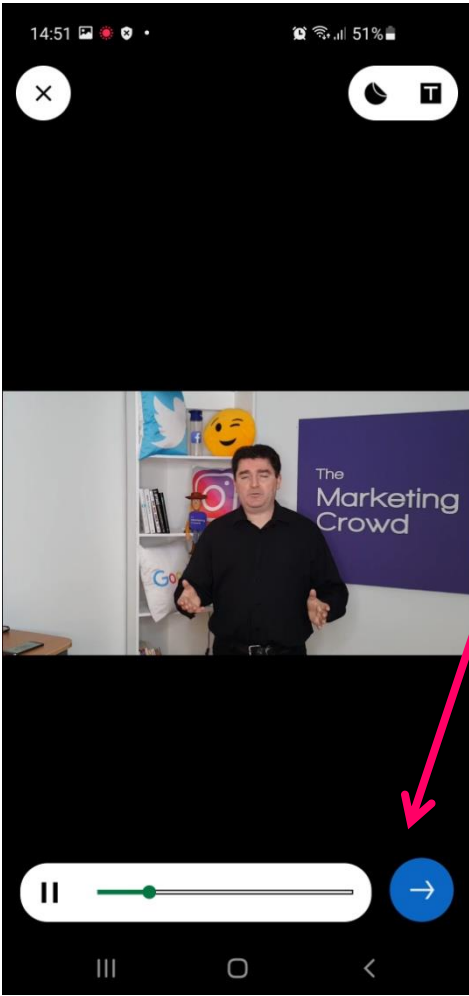
Then tap on the gallery icon to choose a video from your phone
