Mobile app Video editor – CapCut





Go to the app store or play store on your phone. Search for and download CapCut

Over 400 million people use Inshot

It is made by Bytedance - the same company that owns TikTok so there is a lot of integration with TikTok

It's like Canva in that you can use most of it for free.

However, they have lots of Pro features and to use those you would need to be a monthly Pro user (approx €10 / month)

In this course I will be showing you how to make videos for free

Why use CapCut rather than just make your videos in Instagram reels?




By using CapCut you can ..

- Make videos for any social platform, YouTube and your website
- Much better text effects and can import fonts
- Much better captions
- Much better transitions
- · Can overlay footage
- Can overlay graphics from Canva and remove background


And if you create the video in CapCut you can then

 Select it as a video for your Reel and then add copyright music like Wham or Mariah Carey as part of the Reel creation process.


How to get started editing a video




- When you open the app this is your main menu.
- Note that there are options at the top. You can choose one of these options before entering the editor if you wish. Eg you want to add captions or use the teleprompter.
- Note tap the dropdown arrow to display more
- At the bottom you have an option to use their premade templates
- To edit a video simply tap on New Project



How to get started editing a video




- You can now choose videos from your phone
- Note you can also browse through their free stock video and free stock image library
- To get to an album on your phone tap the dropdown next to album
- When you find the album, select the clip that you want.
 Tap HD to use the HD version of the clip











- Tap split


To reduce the volume of your clips


Tap on a clip
Then tap volume


Reduce the volume by dragging the slider to the left


To reduce the volume of other clips simply tap on another clip at this stage and you can drag the Slider


Or tap loudness adjustment and it will reduce the volume of all other clips to match what you did in the first











To add music

Slide to the end of your video and you will see that the music is longer than your video


Position the line at the point you want to cut the music

Then tap split and delete the part you don't want

You should now fade out the music

Tap fade and fade out for around 2.5 sec





To add Text


Pause your video where you want to add text. The text will be added just to the right of the white line.

Tap on Text in the main menu

Type your text in the bex


Browse though the fonts and choose one that you like.

If you want to upload a Christmas font you can tap Add Font






Follow the instructions to open the font file

To add Text

You can also change the colour and style of the text

Beside, Font, Tap on Style


I chose this red outline


Play around with styles, colours

Also try animations to have your text animate in or out

To indicate where you want the text to start and end drag the Sliders

Also, if you want to duplicate the text in order to use it elsewhere in the video, tap on the text box and then duplicate






To export your video

Tap the arrow in the top right of the screen

Your video will export


It will be placed in your camera folder

If you want to change the video to Portrait shape (9:16)




To change the aspect ratio – shape

Swipe left on the main menu to see Aspect Ratio]]Select the aspect ratio / shape you want to change it to eg. 9:16 for portrait



If you want to change the video to Portrait shape (9:16)




To change the aspect ratio – shape

With 2 fingers, pinch on the video to expand it to portrait to fill the screen


Swipe left to the next clip and also pinch that one to expand it

Repeat with all the clips













To add a voice over


Your voiceover will now be added to the timeline below your video




















Slide to the end of your video and you will see that the music is longer than your video


Position the line at the point you want to cut the music

Then tap split and delete the part you don't want

You should now fade out the music

Tap fade and fade out for around 2.5 sec






To export your video

Tap the arrow in the top right of the screen

Your video will export

It will be placed in your camera folder

Optional Extra 1 – you could add some Christmas stickers



You could add some Xmas themed stickers to your video eg. Xmas tree, wreath etc.


Pause where in the video you want to add the sticker. It will be added after the white line

Then tap on text


Then tap on sticker

Then search for Christmas

Choose a sticker and it will appear on the video, Position it where you want it




Optional Extra 1 – you could add some Christmas stickers



You can then decide where you want the sticker to start and end by dragging the sliders for the sticker on the timeline

Optional Extra 2 – you could add some Christmas effects like snow or stars / glitter




In the main menu tap on effects

Then tap on video effects


Then search for Christmas

Tap on the effect you wan to add
and it will appear on your video.

You can then drag the slier on the timeline to indicate when you want the effect to start and end



Optional Extra 3 – you could overlay some graphics from Canva




Open the Canva app on your Phone

Choose a square or Portrait sized Canvas


Tap on elements in order to search for graphics

Search for Christmas or Christmas Border


Browse though and add what you want to the Canva








Position the image where you want it

Then, to remove the Background

- 1. Tap the image
- Then find and tap remove BG
- 3. Then tap Chromakey if you are using free version
- Then tap the white area of the image and it will remove the white background




Your graphic is now on the video without the white background


However, if you want this to run for the length of the video don't forget to stretch the slider for the overlay to the end of the video




To overlay footage on top of your video


Play and then pause at the point where you would like to overlay footage

Tap on Overlay in the bottom menu

Find the footage / video that you want to overlay. Tap to select

Tap HD and then add





To overlay footage on top of your video

The video now appears on top of your main video.

You can pinch it with 2 fingers to expand it to completely cover the main video


On the timeline the video appears below the main video


Press play and pause where you want the footage to end


Tap on the footage clip on the timeline


Then tap split and delete



























































Want to add Mariah Carey or Wham Xmas music on Instagram Reels?

You can do this but do not add music within CapCut. Export your final video without music

Go to your Instagram Account. Note, it needs to be a personal account or a Creator account to have the copyright music (Business accounts do not have copyright music)


Tap on +
Then Tap on Reel






Select the video from your phones gallery that you exported from CapCut Then tap on the music icon to search for and choose music





Search for Christmas Choose your music (Wham, Mariah Carey etc) Then tap done







By default, Instagram will mute the audio in your video and the music will be at 100% volume

You want to reduce the music volume and you want to restore the audio of you speaking

- 1. Tap on the icon for controls
- 2. Drag the slider to the left to reduce the volume of the music
- 3. Tap the x icon on audio to restore the audio from your video
- 4. Then tap done




They have some brilliant Christmas video templates that you should Consider – these don't require any Editing


When you first open the app tap on Templates

Then search for Christmas

Choose a template by tapping on it

Then tap Use template

It will then tell you how many images or videos you need to select form your phone

Select them by tapping

Then tap Next

You will then be shown your video with all of your files in it.

Tap export to save it to your phone
