Getting AI videos for free is far less common than free AI images



Very few of the AI companies give you free video creation. It is something you typically have to pay for and even when you do, there are restrictions in terms of length, resolution, and quantity

Why?

Creating a 5-second AI-generated video is significantly more costly than creating images in terms of both computing power and direct monetary cost—than generating a single AI-generated image.

A 5-second video typically costs \$2.50 to \$5, while a single image costs just \$0.02 to \$0.06 on average through major providers.

The quality of AI videos is not as high as AI images. Mistakes are common



The quality of AI videos is high but not as high as images.

What you will find when you generate videos is that issues are far more common than with images e.g. Too many fingers, things disappearing

Why?

It is technically more difficult to create videos
The technology is around 12-15 months behind where AI image creation is because images are easier.

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Sora – create videos just by describing them



Chat GPT launched Sora in the US and many other countries at the end of 2024 and it rolled out to Ireland in February 2025

It is currently only available to paid users and to use it you have to go to www.sora.com and login with your Chat GPT login.

You can then type in your prompt describing the type of video you want. You can choose the shape (landscape / portrait / square) , the length (currently 10 seconds max) and how many versions you want (up to 4).

You can also attach an image and it will turn the image into a video

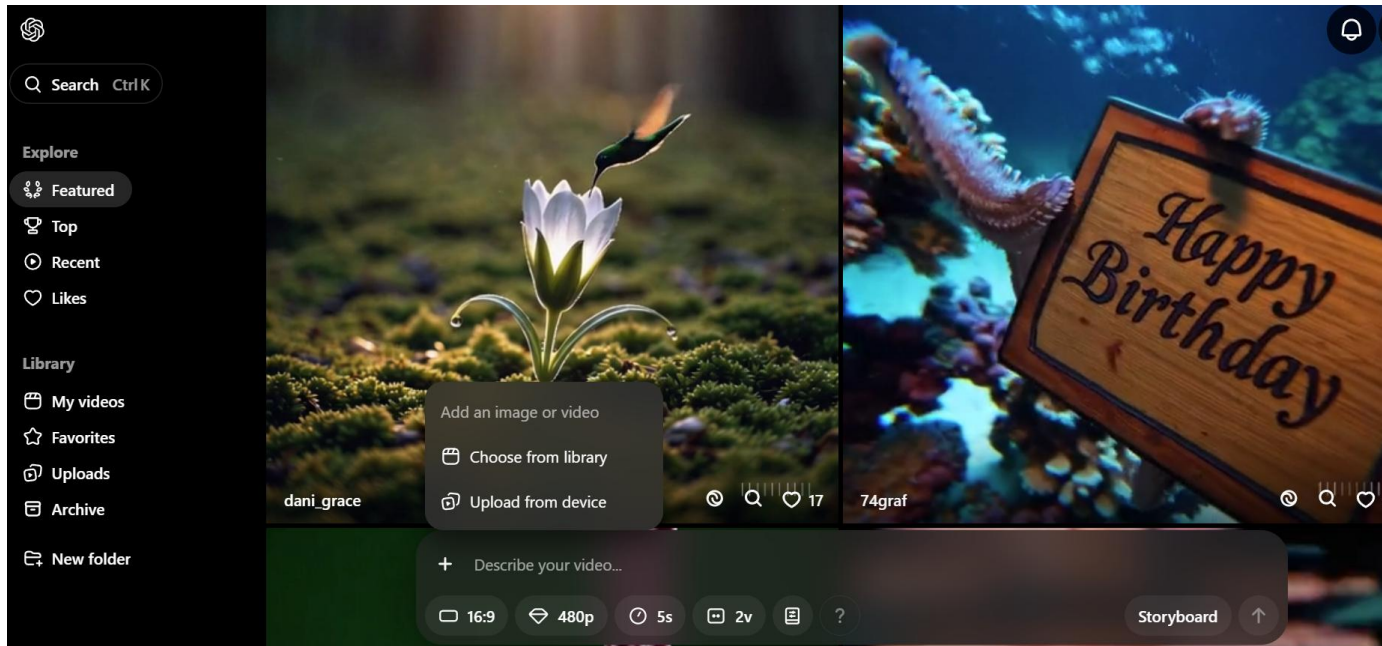

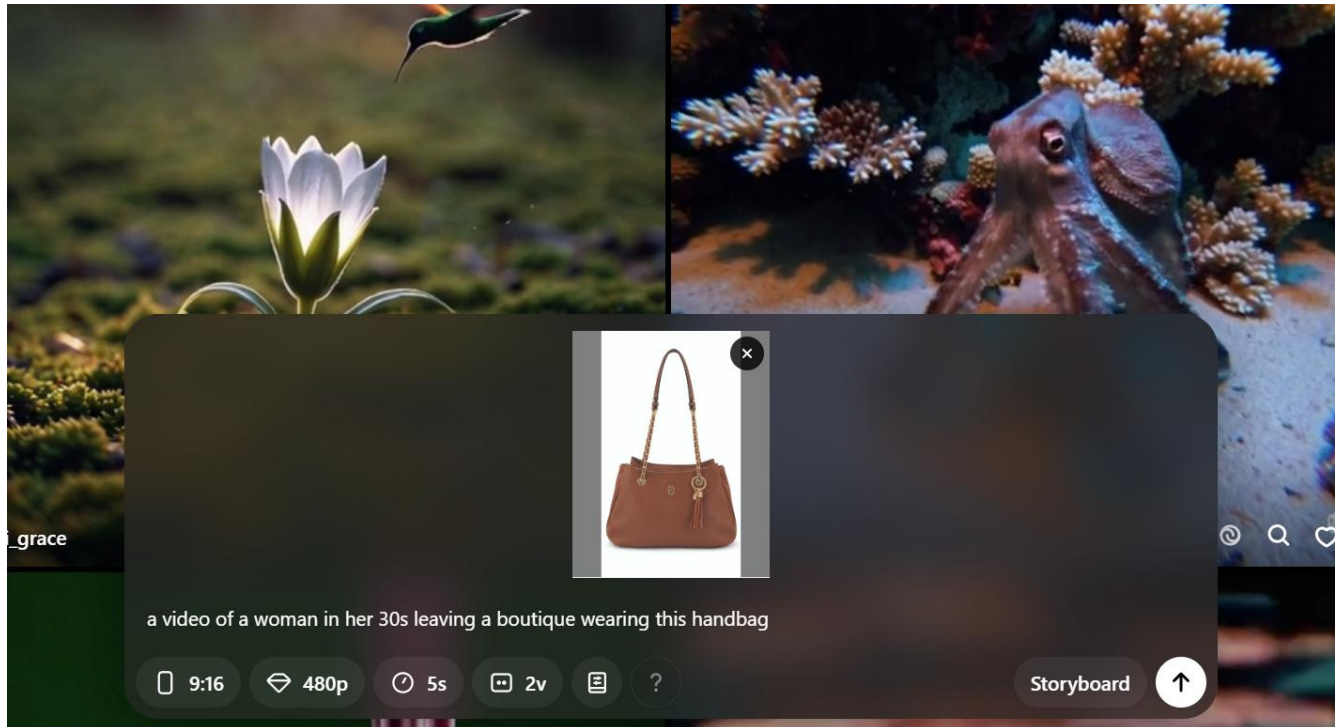

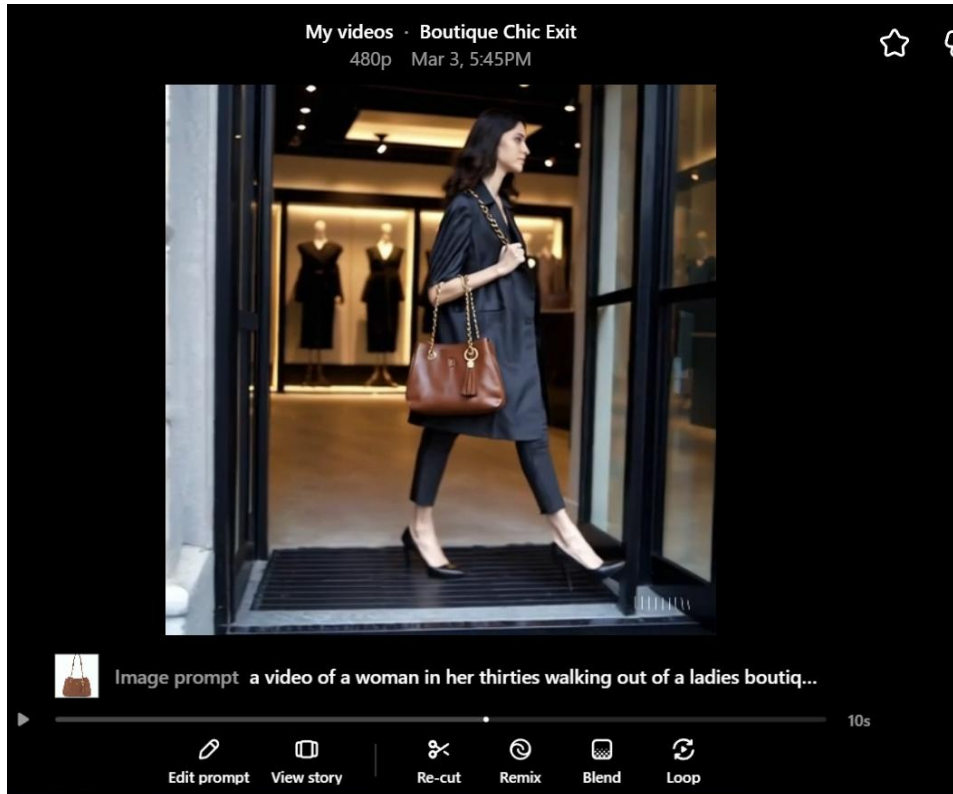

My Verdict

It's good. But there are often errors in the videos.

You can then view the videos that were created

You can also make some revisions to the video, blend it with another one

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Google Veo 3 within Canva – create videos just by describing them

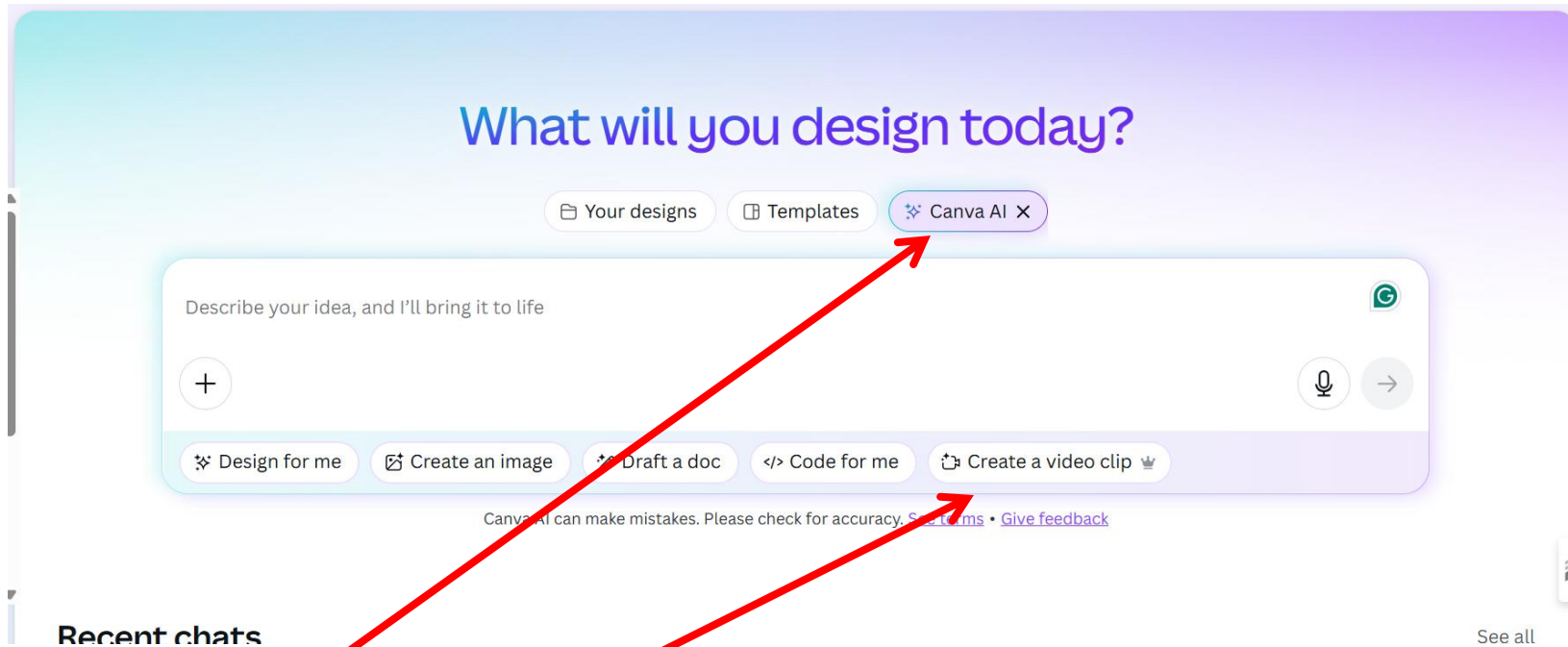


Canva has teamed up with Google's video creation tool called VEO 3

This is the equivalent of Sora within the paid version of Chat GPT

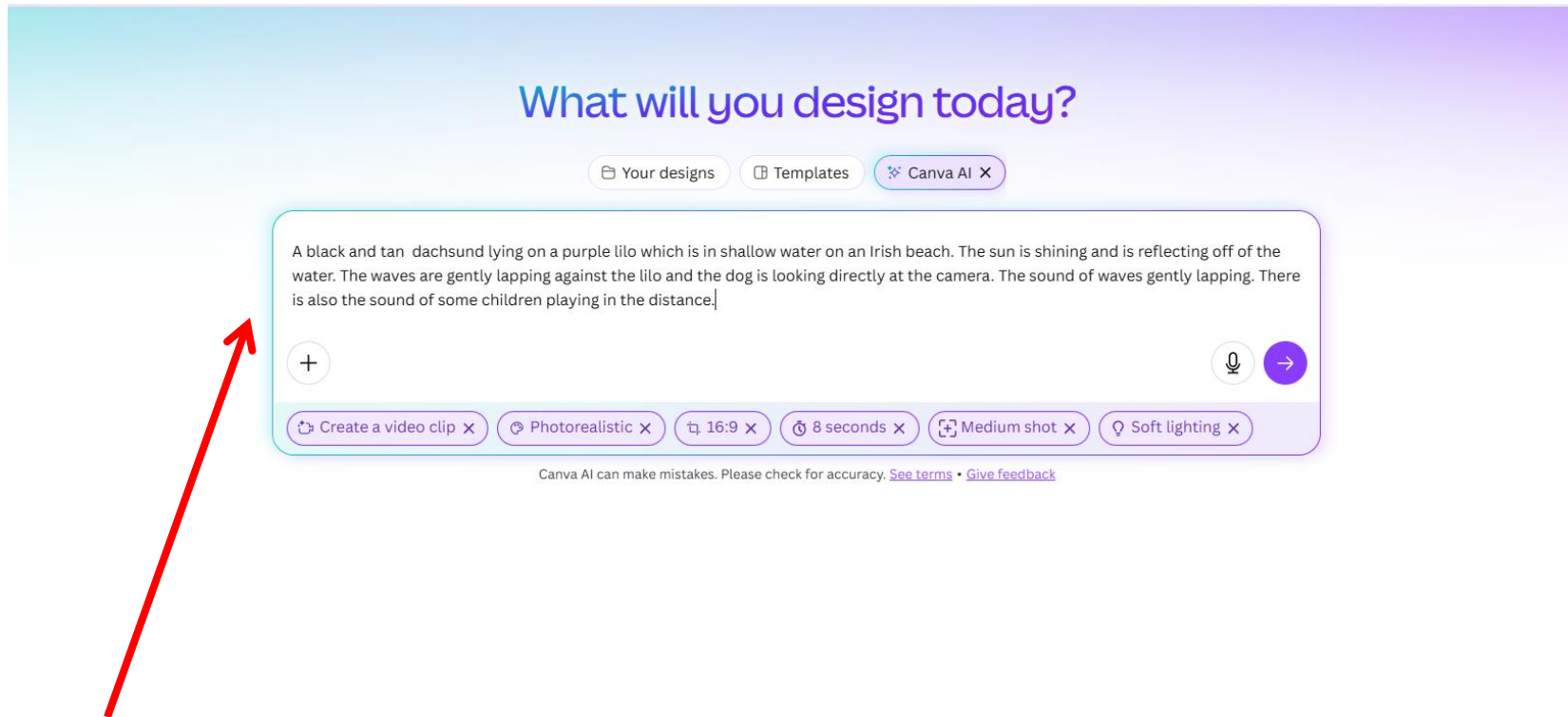
- Only available to paid users
- You get to create 5 videos a month
- You can type in a prompt or attach an image

Click on Canva AI
Then click on Create a video

Describe what you want the video to be

You can attach an image of you want the AI to reference it

Note – you can also choose Style, Aspect ratio, duration, framing and lighting

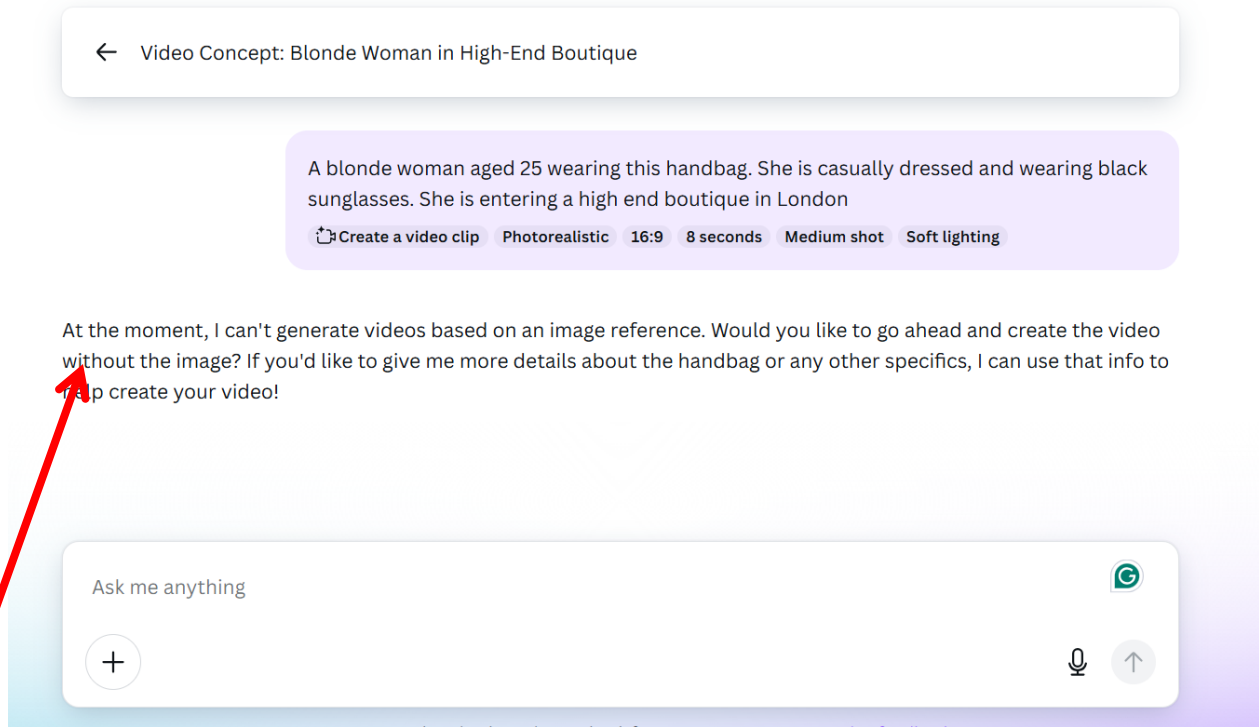

Google Veo 3 within Canva – create a video by attaching an image

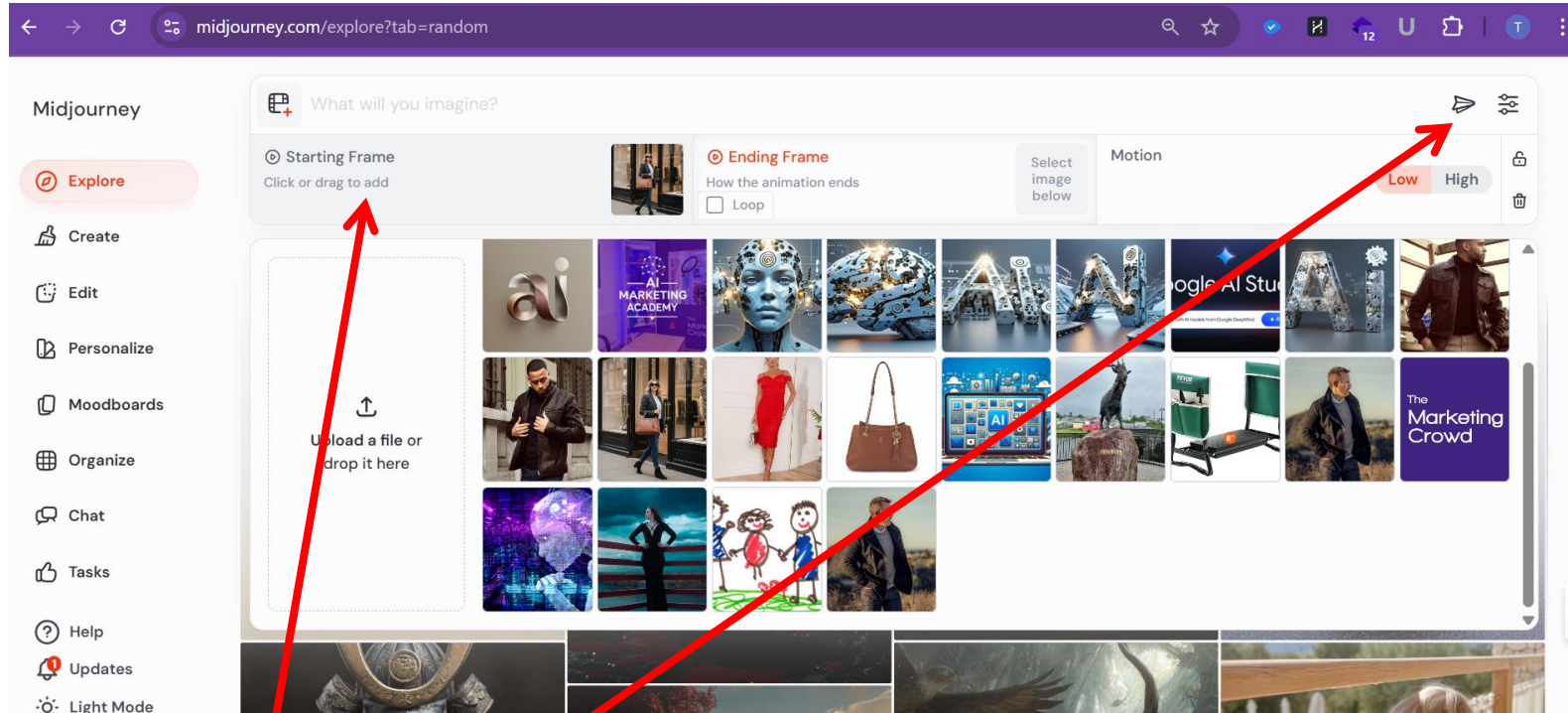


My Verdict:

The quality of the video is very good

However, the bag in the video was very close but not identical. There was an extra tassel

Midjourney – create a video by attaching an image



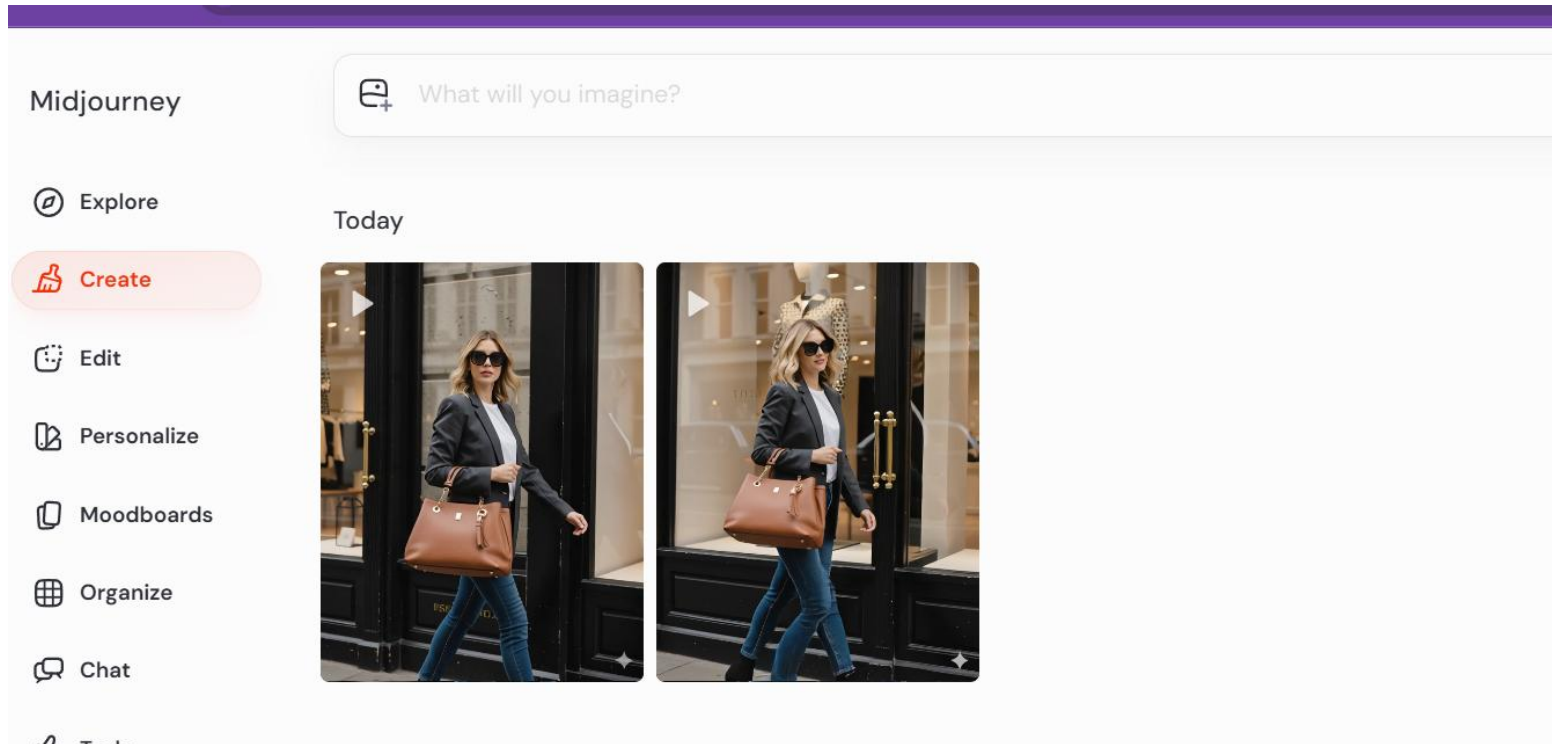
Click on Create

Attach an image and set it as the start frame

The image will be the same dimension / shape as the image you attach so attached a 9:16 if you want 9:16

Hit submit

Midjourney – create a video by attaching an image



Your videos will then be produced

The quality of the videos is very good

Openart.ai - Create a video by choosing from the leading video models



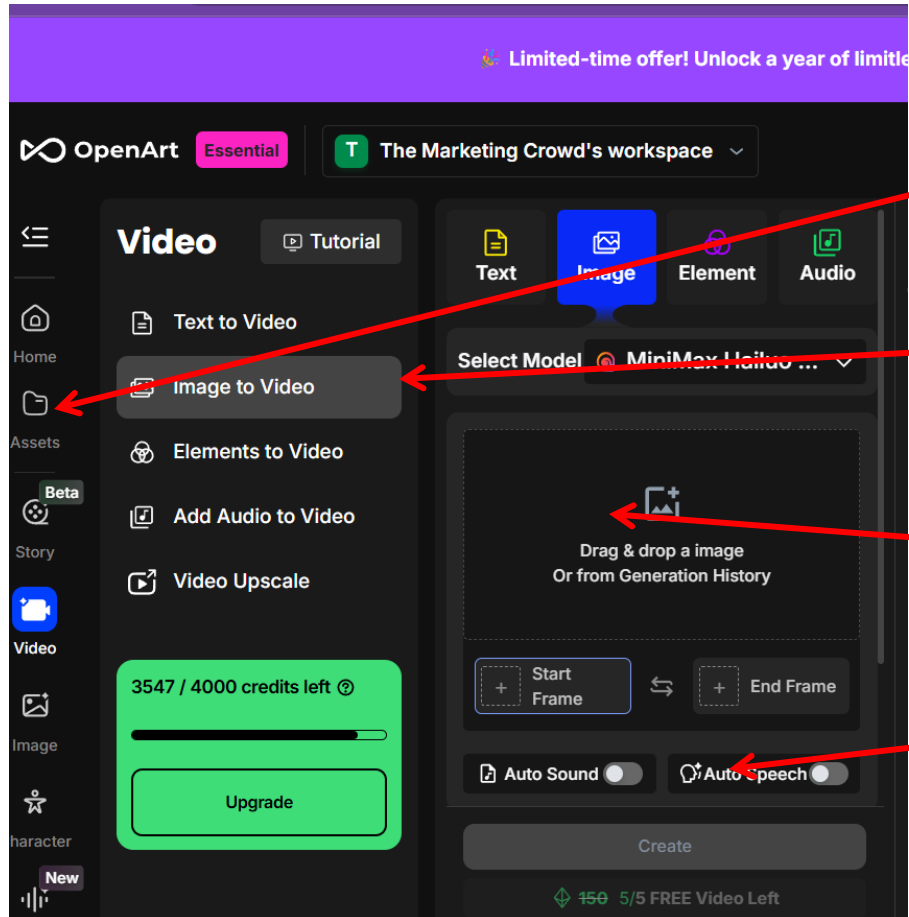
Open Art is the AI image and video tool that allows you to choose from all the main tools when you are creating content

It is a paid tool but it gives you some free credits to try it.

When creating a video you can describe what you want or you can attach an image as your prompt

The latter would be very useful for your marketing

Openart.ai - Create a video by choosing from the leading video models



Note – you can also choose which model you want to use. Some cost a LOT more credits than others

On the left menu click on Video

Then choose if you want

Text to video (Describe what you want)
Image to video (Attach an image) This would be good for your products

Click upload

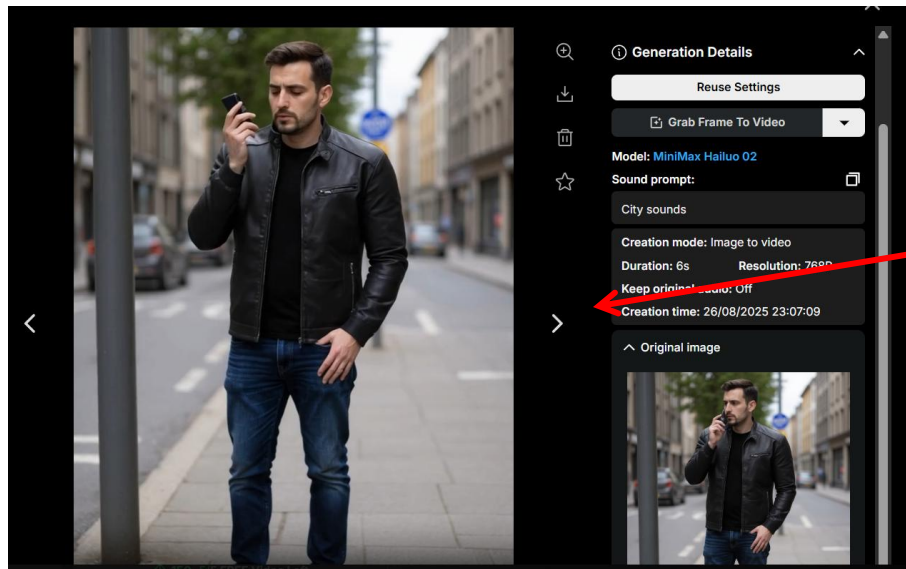
Choose if you want the image to be start frame or the end frame

Choose if you want the AI to generate sound in the video

Choose the length

It also tells you how many of your credits this video will use

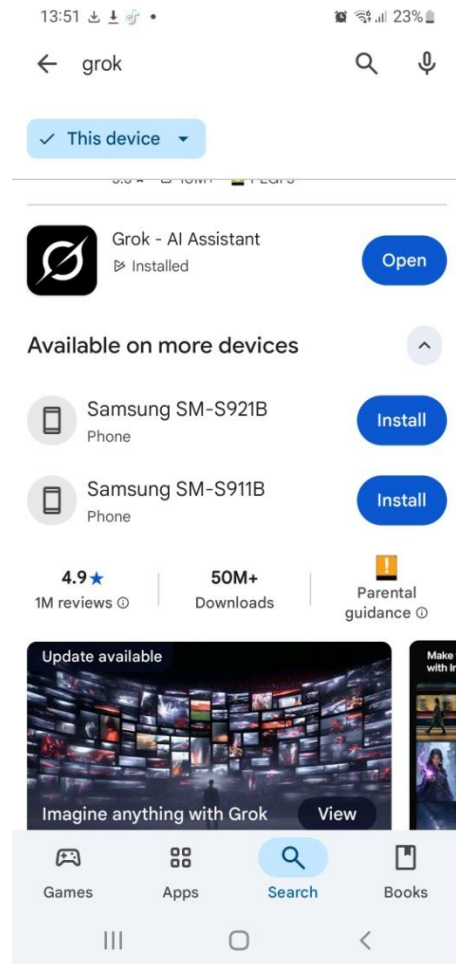
Try the image & video tool in Grok AI



Grok is the AI developed by Elon Musk and it has made huge advances in the past 12 months.

It recently added a very interesting image & video creation tool which are 100% free

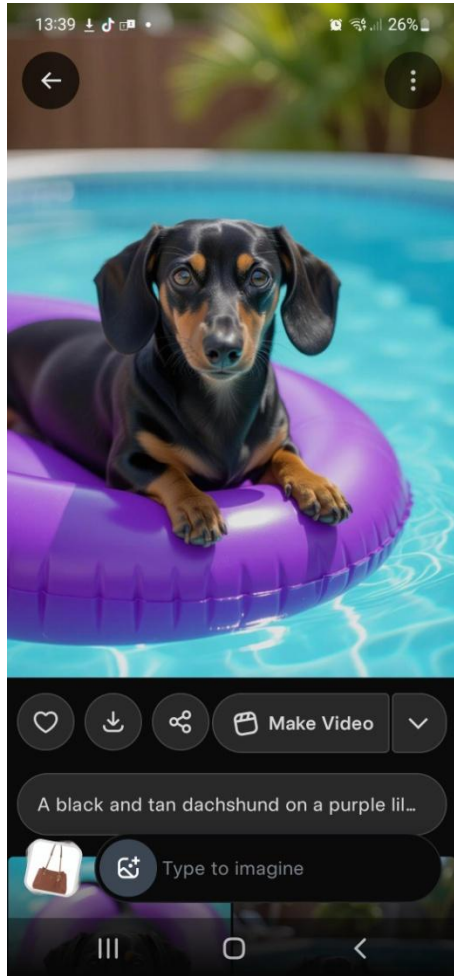
Create images for free using Grok



Go to the app store or the play store and download the Grok App

You can login with your X account or login using your Google account

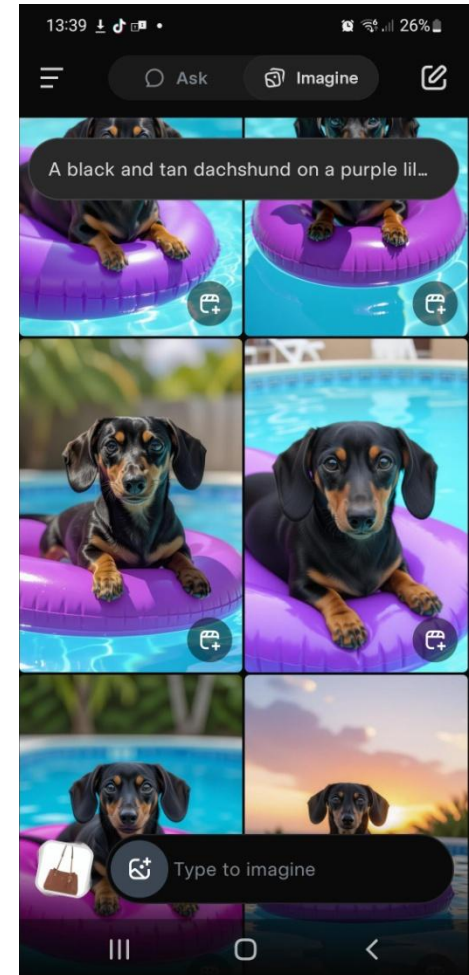
Create images for free using Grok



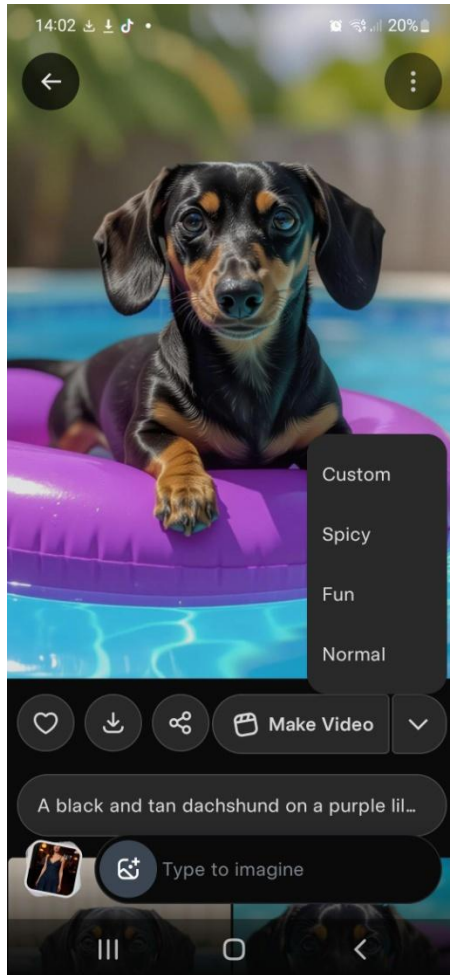
Tap on Imagine for the creative area within Grok

Type in the prompt for your image

What is great about Grok is that it very quickly gives you loads to choose from



Turn your images into videos using Grok



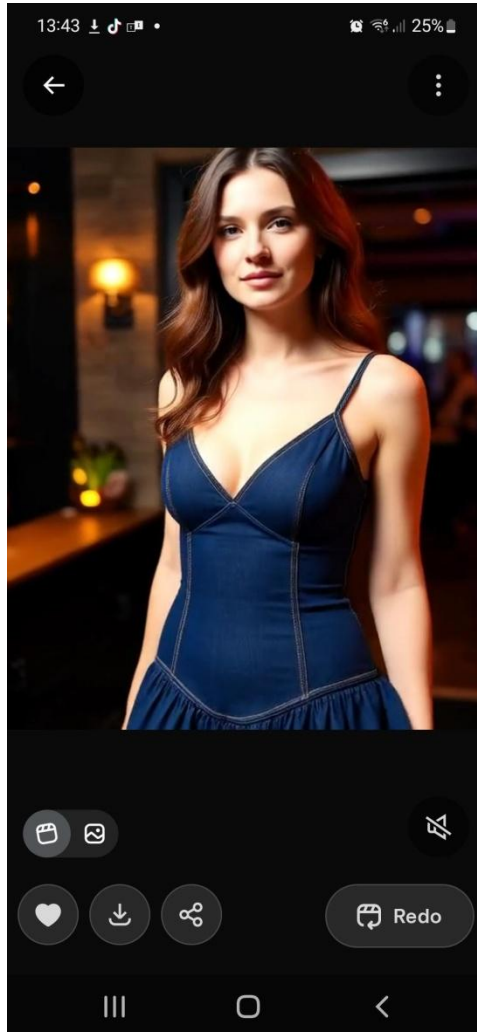
You can turn an image that you created in Grok into a short video which you could use as footage in a marketing video or use it in a Reel

1, Next to make a video tap the arrow
2. Choose Normal and it will create a normal video

Choose custom and you can include instructions. Choose fun and it will create a fund video

You can then download the video to your phone

Turn your images into videos using Grok



You can also attach an image from your phone and it will turn it into a short video

This could be very useful if you attach images of your products

If you select custom you can add custom instructions for the video.

Verdict

The videos are quick to produce and look good. They are free to create so you should definitely try this for your product images

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Other CapCut tools

Edit a video simply by deleting text – CapCut desktop

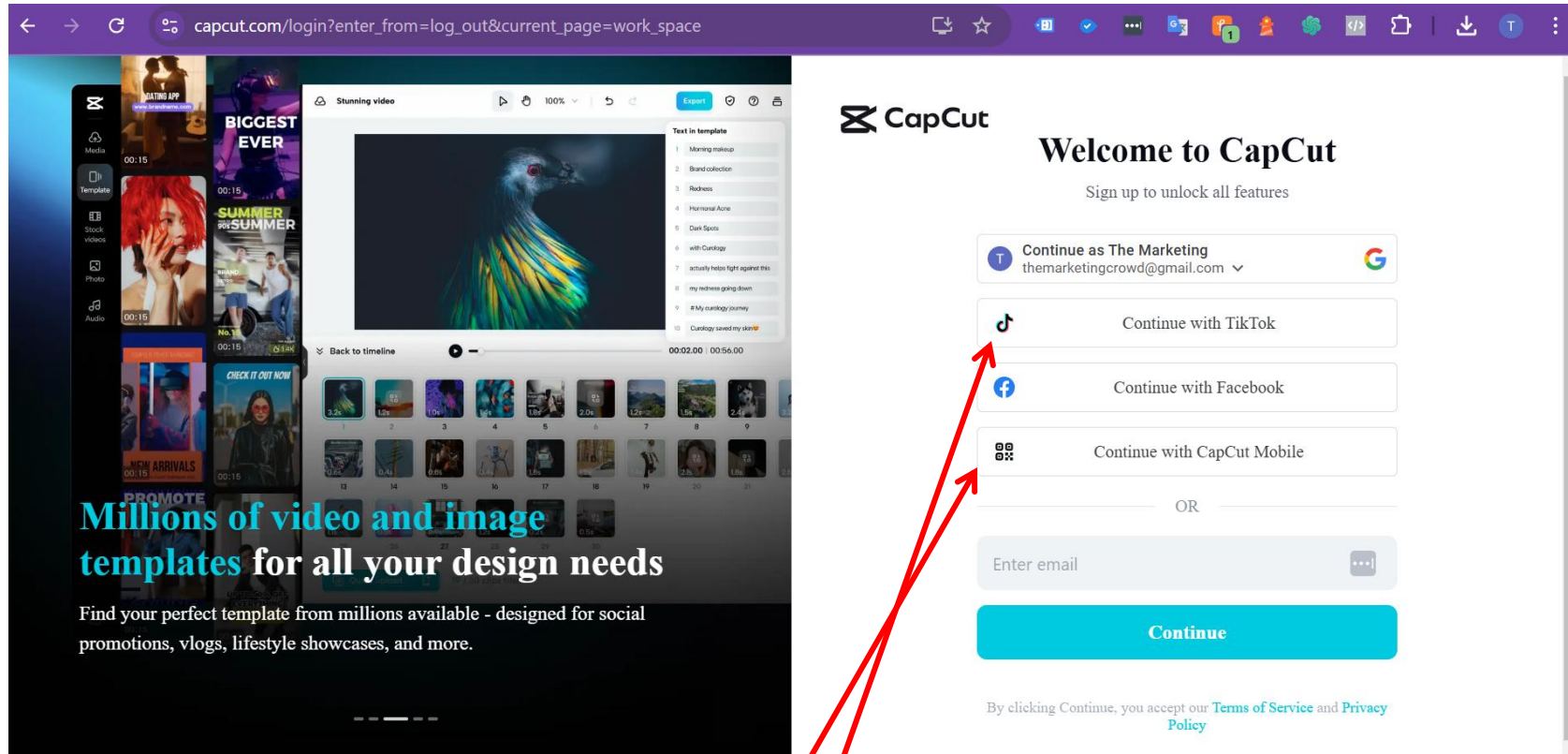


You can use the desktop version of CapCut by going to [CapCut.com](https://www.capcut.com)

Most (but not all) of the features are free).

Simply create a free account and login

How to get started

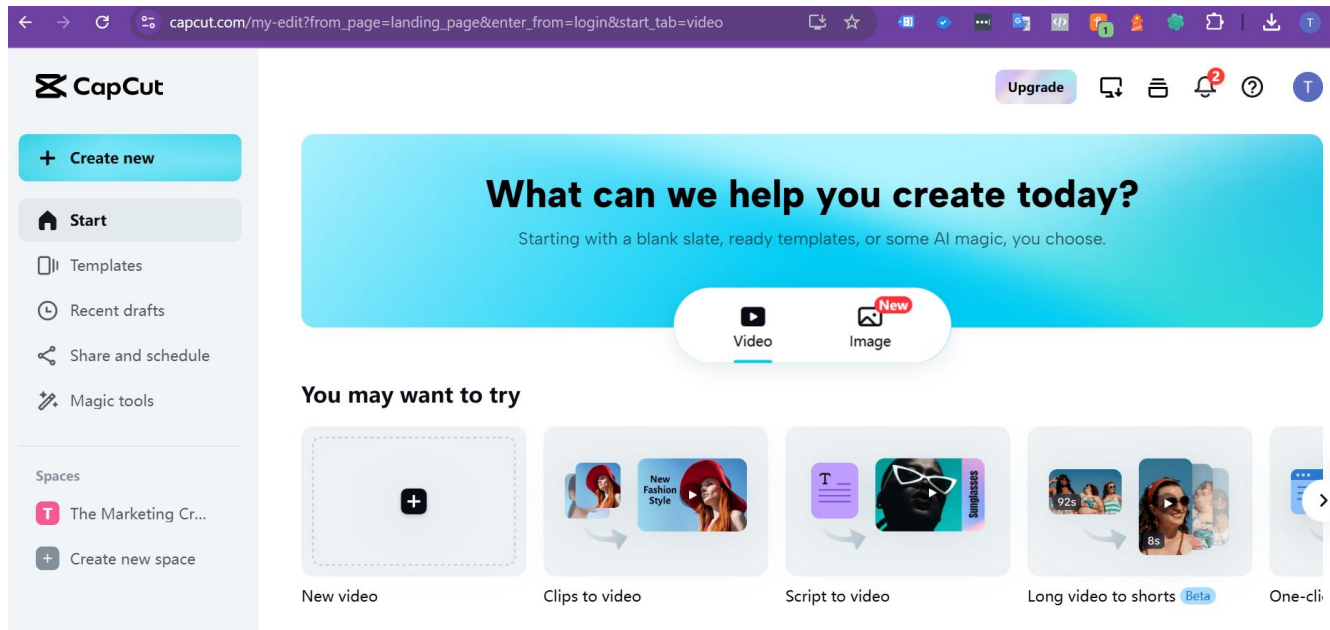


Go to CapCut.com on your browser.

You should then create an account.

1. Got a CapCut account on mobile? Select this option and follow instructions.
2. Got a TikTok account? You can login using that
3. Or create an account by logging in with your Gmail

How to get started – Home screen



This is your Home screen.

Create New – Click this to start editing a new video

Start – This is the equivalent of Home

Templates – browse through their templates and simply add your images / videos

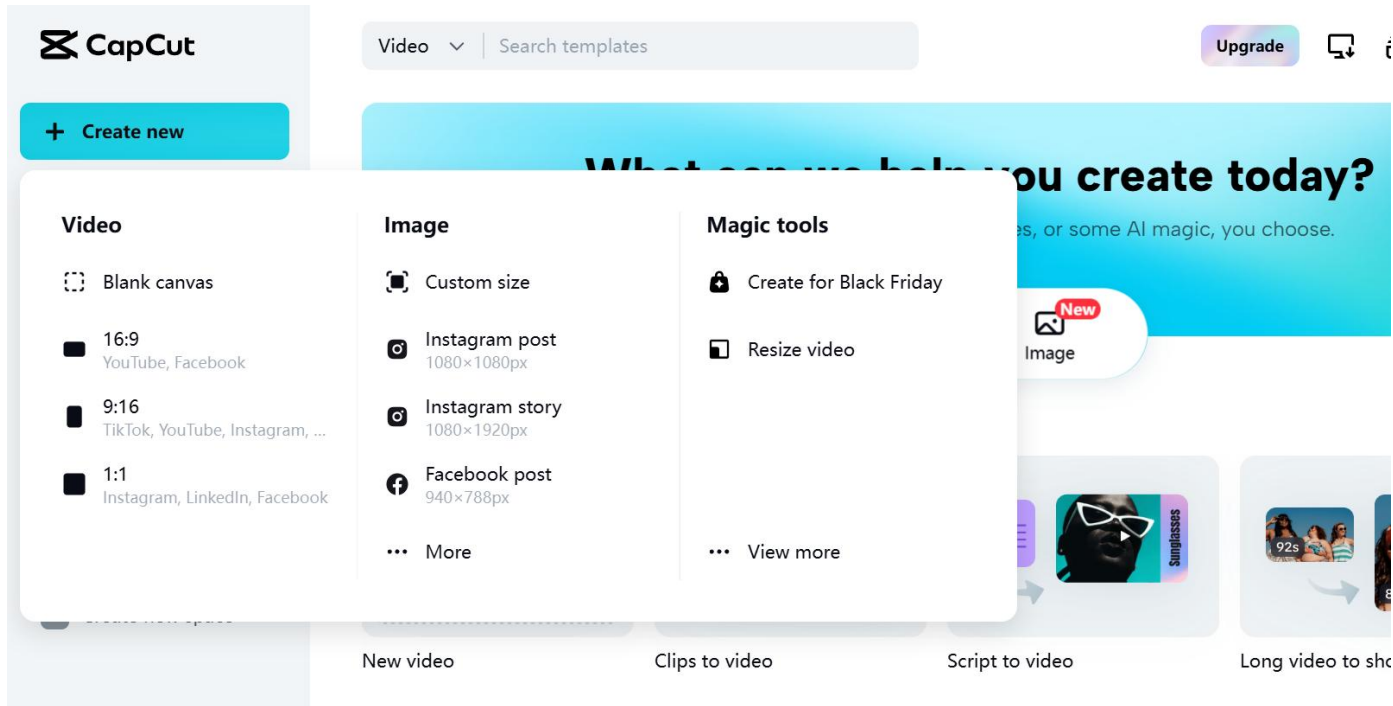
Recent drafts – all your previous video projects live here. You can go back and continue editing them

Share / schedule – people (collaborators) can share video projects with you

Magic tools – they have LOTS of AI tools. They all live here

Spaces – You are given 5gb of storage for free. Your videos take up this storage. If you exceed this you would need to delete files or upgrade for 100gb of storage in the Pro plan

How to get started – Create a video

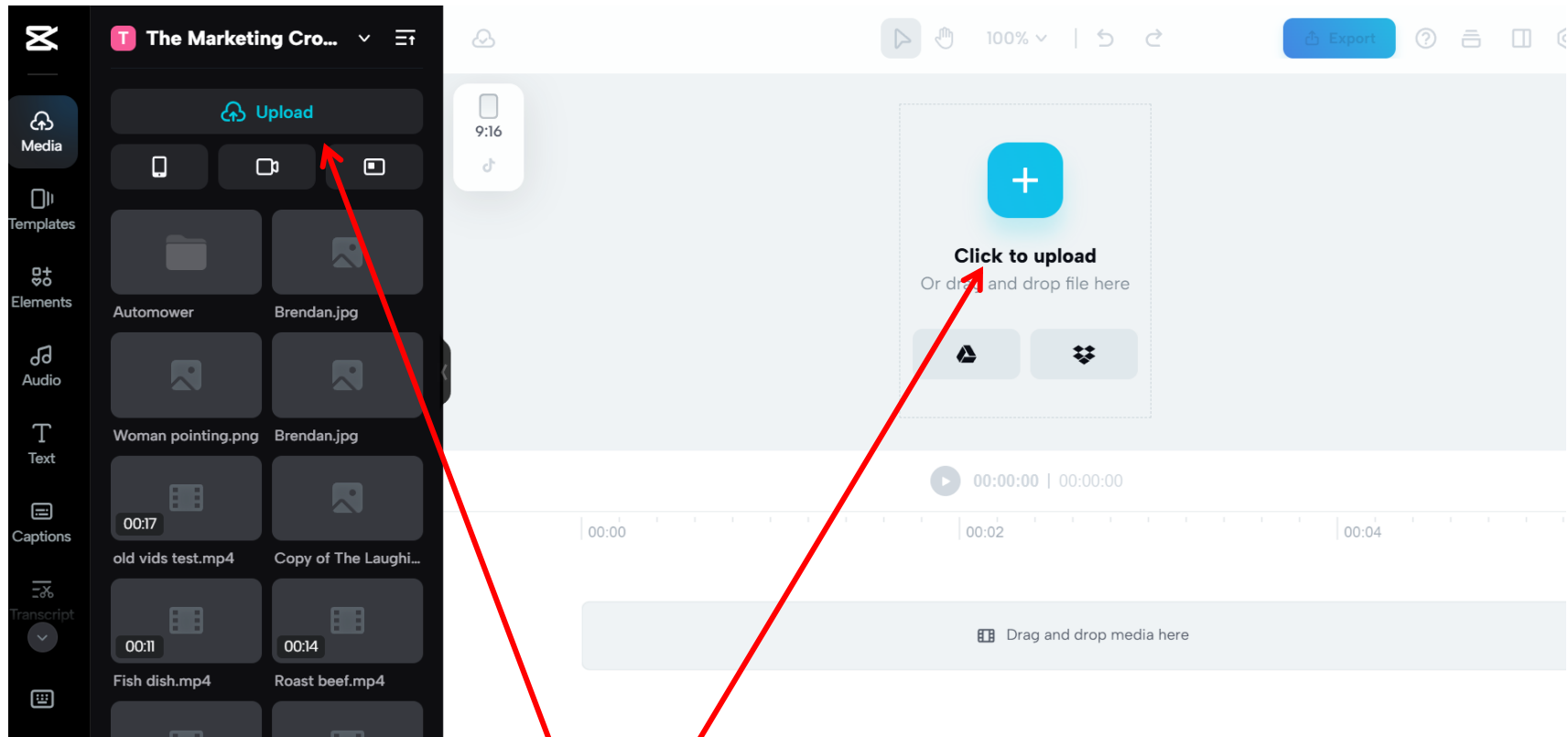


Click on Create new

You can use CapCut to edit images as well – similar to Canva

We want to edit a video so choose your size (16:9 , 9:16 or square)

How to get started – Create a video

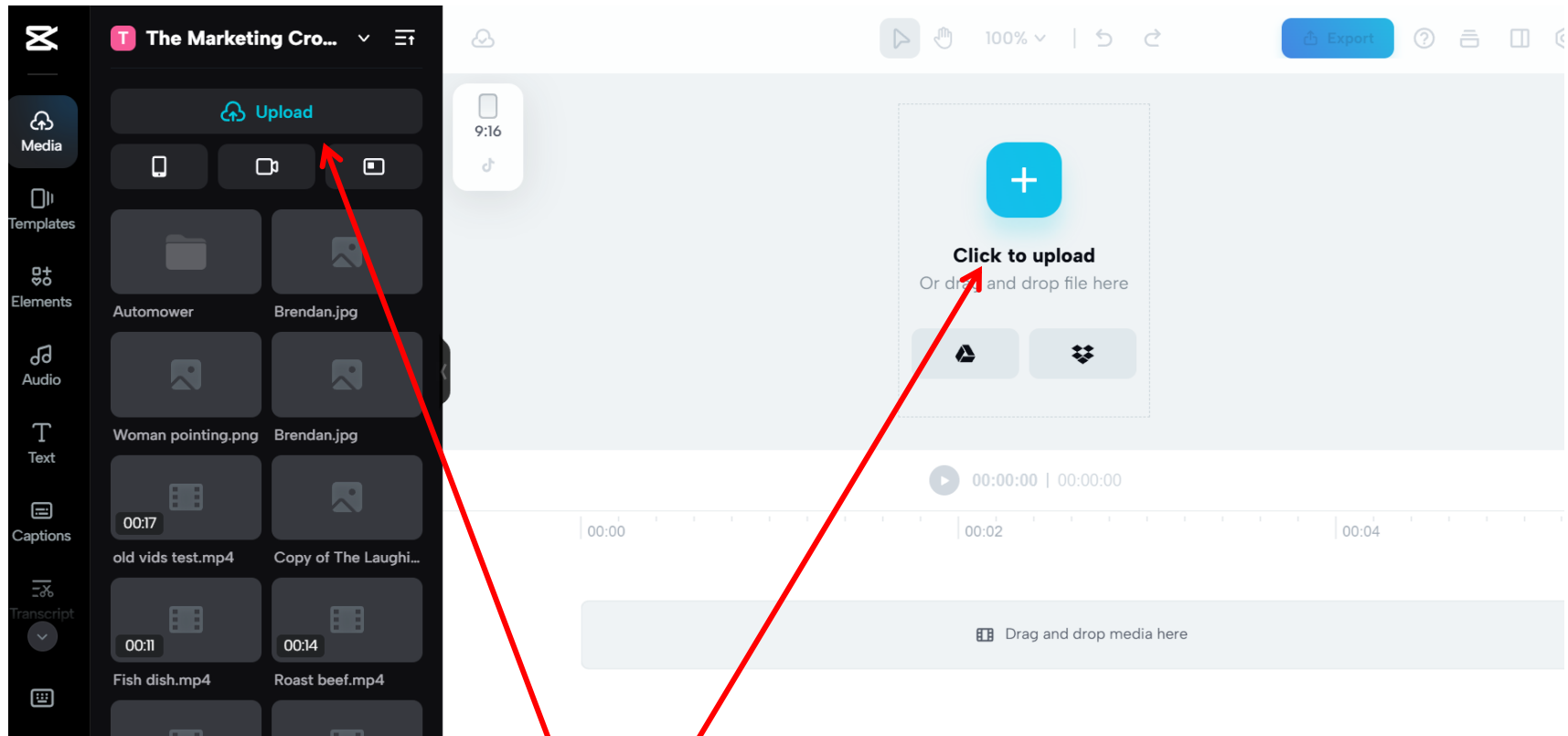


You are now in the editor

Click on upload to upload a video from your computer

Or click on these icons to pull in files from Dropbox or Google drive

How to get started – Create a video

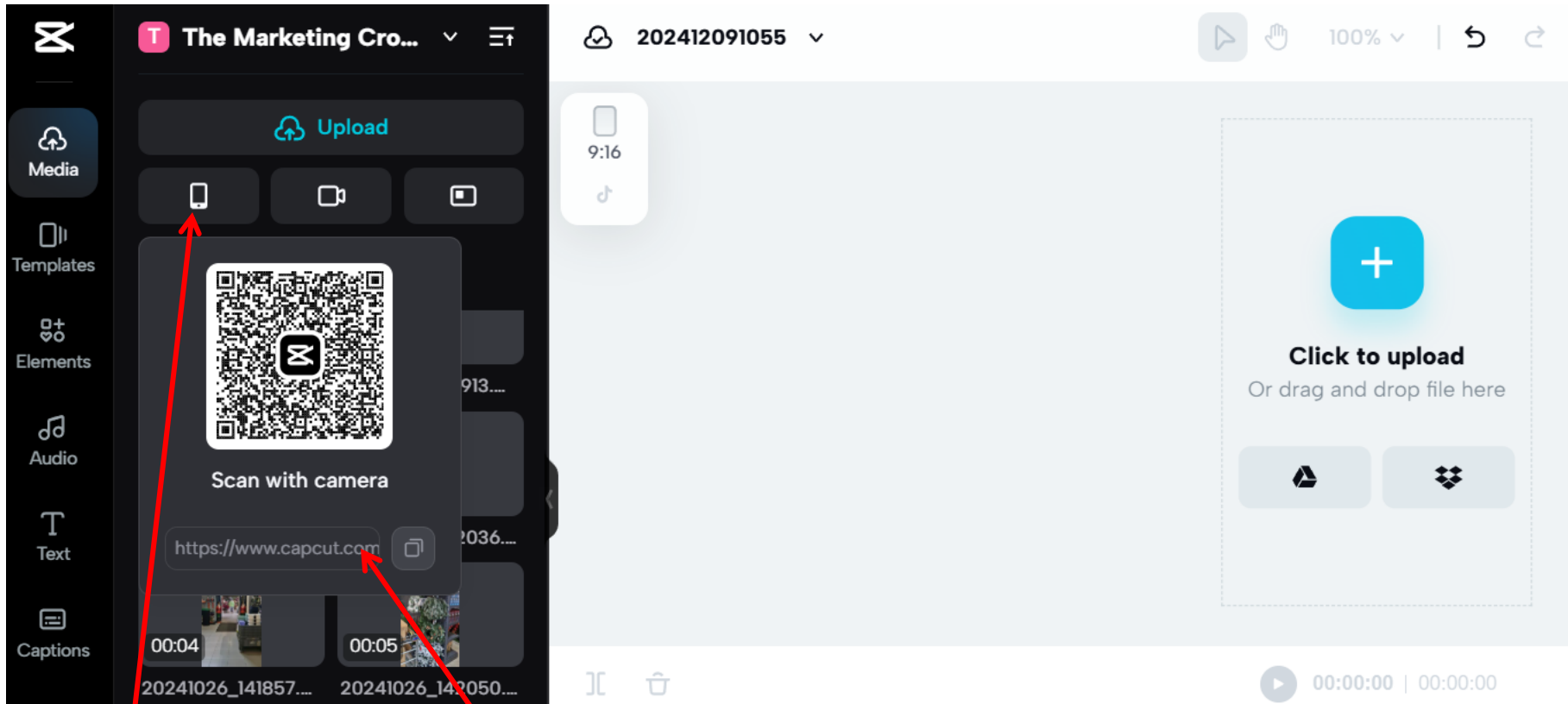


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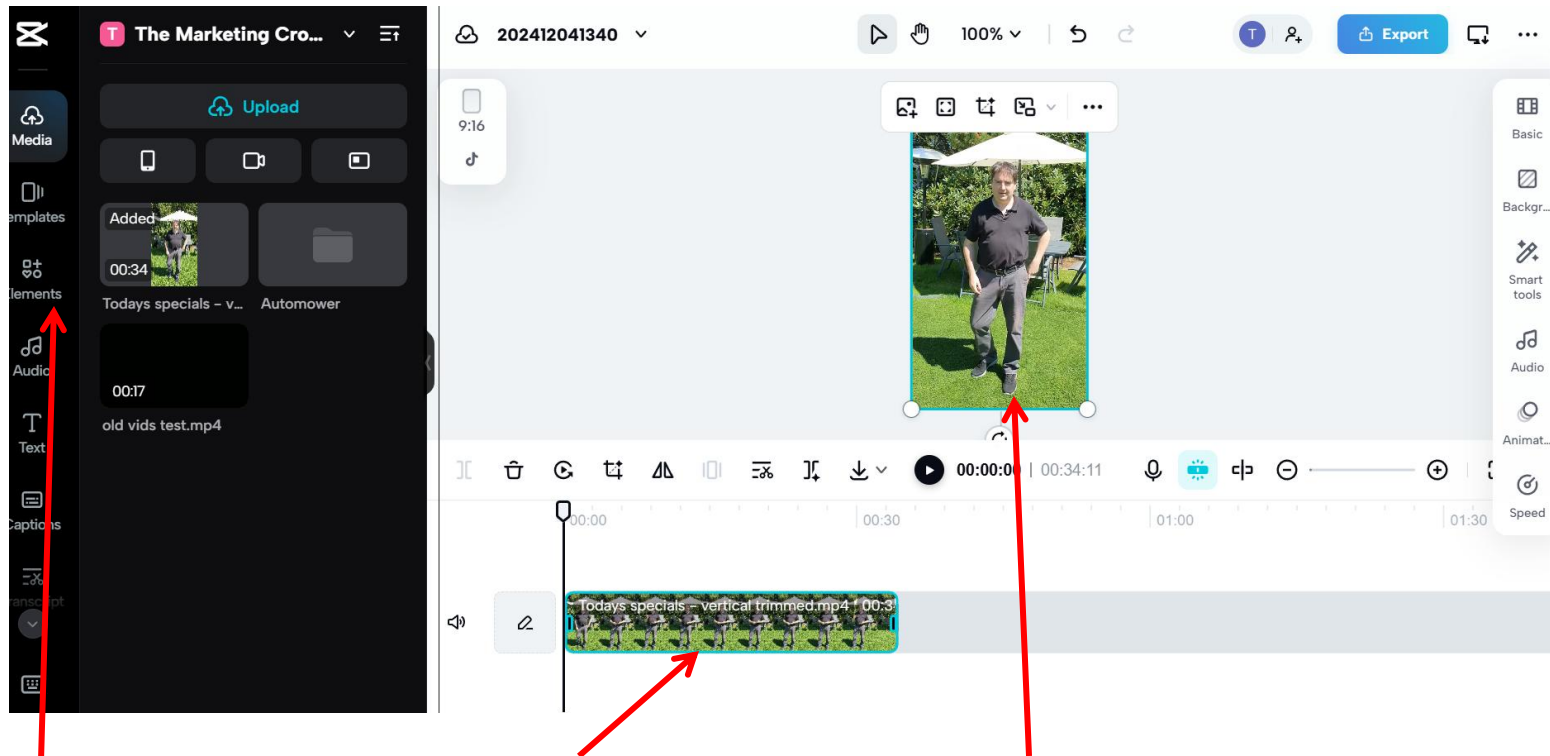
How to get started – Create a video



Or click the phone icon, scan a QR code and you can import videos from your phone

If the QR code doesn't scan, copy this URL, email it to yourself and open it on your phone. You can then upload videos, images and music to your CapCut space

How to get started – Overview of the menus



Drag your video onto the timeline. It will also appear on the playback screen

On the left hand side there is a menu

Elements: search through their stock image and video library to add images or videos to your video

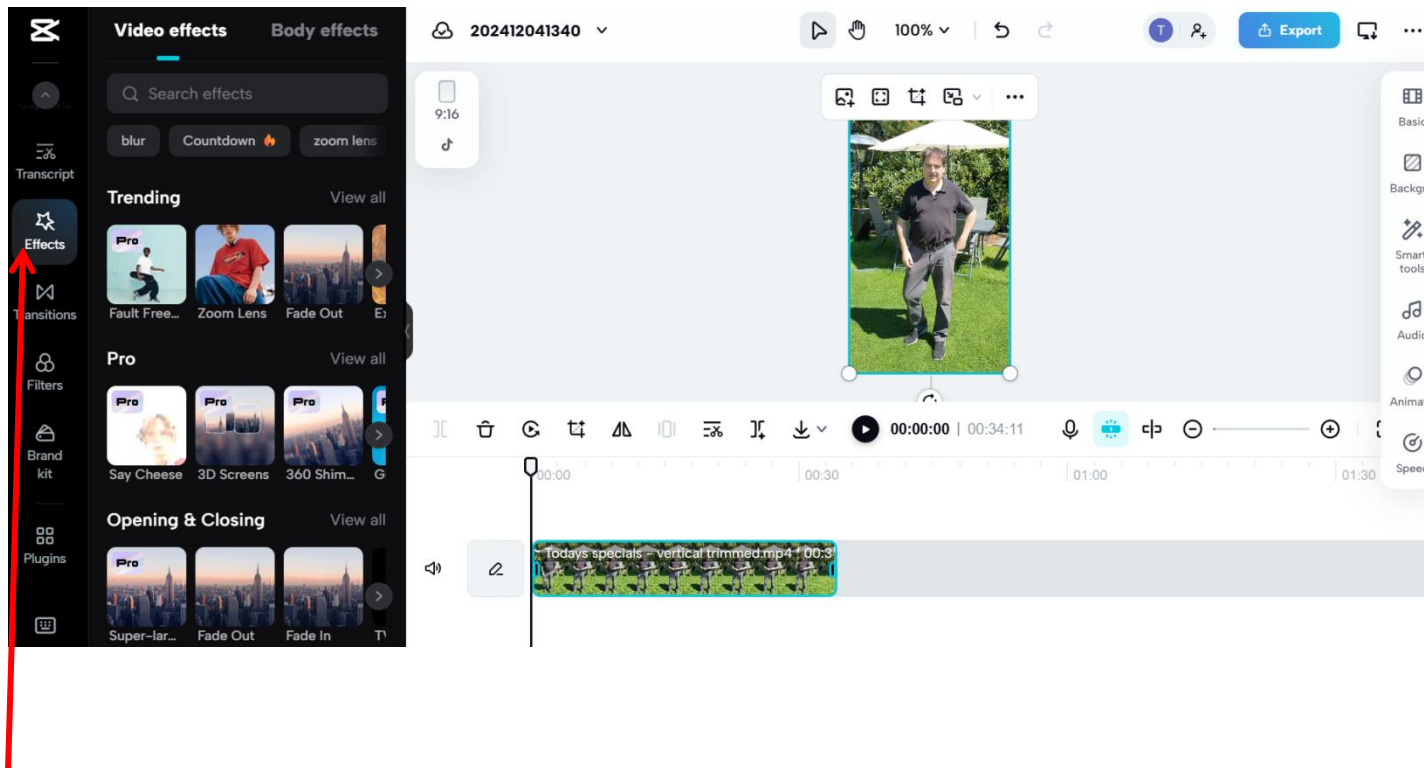
Audio – search through stock music or sound effects – you can then add these to your video

Text – Overlay text onto your video.

Captions: - Generate captions for your video

Transcript – it will generate a transcript and you can edit the video simply by deleting text in the transcript

How to get started – Overview of the menus



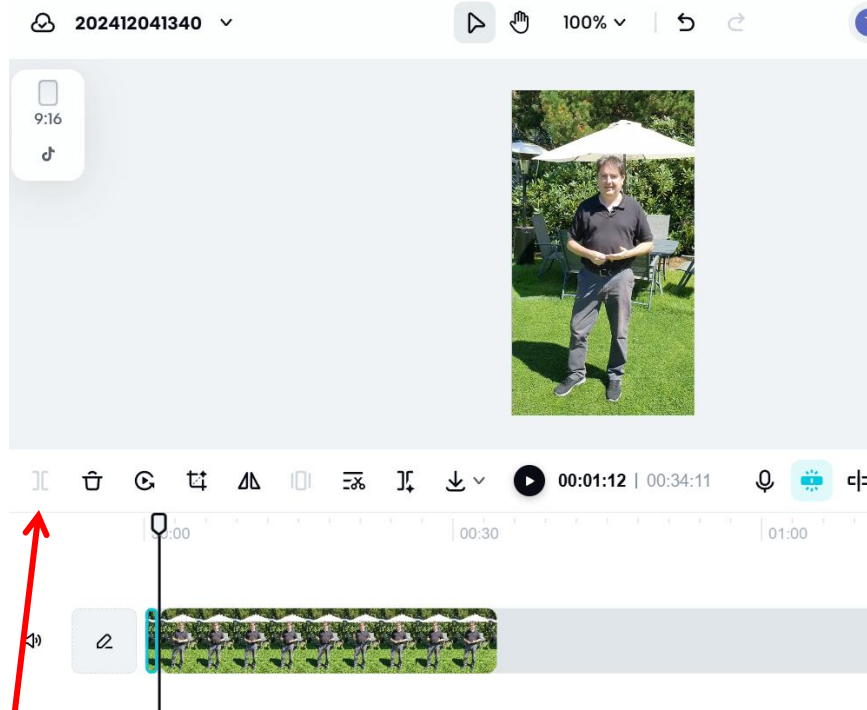
Effects – you can add video effects (snow, confetti) or body effects (laser eyes, funny face) to your video

Transitions – You can add transition effects between clips

Filters – You can add a filter to your video

Brand Kit – you can upload your logo, music, font and it will be available for all of your videos

How to edit a video – someone speaking to camera

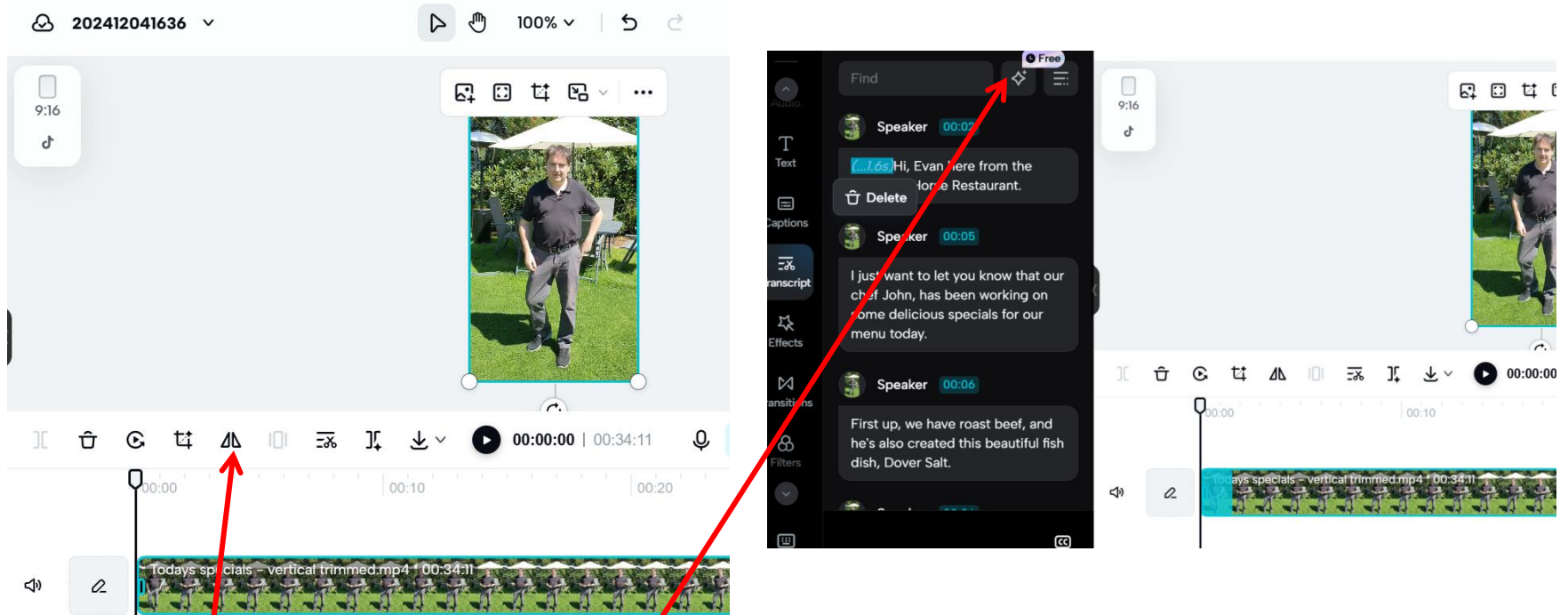


Cut out the parts of the video that you don't want

1. Pause where you want to split the clip
2. Click split
3. Click on the part of the clip you want to delete
4. Click delete

Repeat this process at the end of the video

How to edit a video – someone speaking to camera

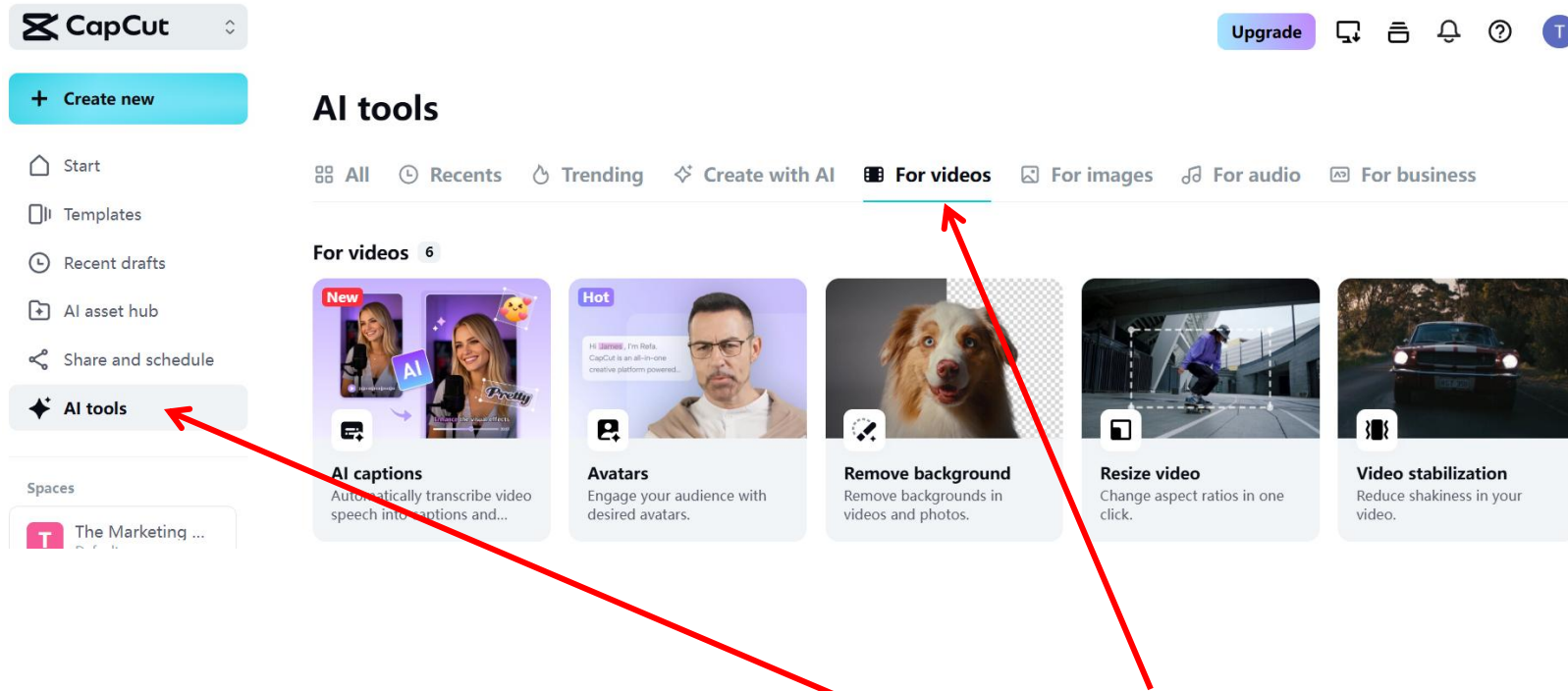


Or cut out parts using transcript based editing

1. Click on your video
2. Click on transcript based editing. It will then generate a transcript of your video
3. Whatever you delete in the transcript will then be deleted from the video.

Note – there is also the option to delete filler words (em etc)

Other CapCut AI video tools that are very useful



Go back to the homepage CapCut.com and click on Ai tools and then For videos

If your video is low resolution – use video up scaler. Upload you video and it will increase the resolution so it will look sharper on larger screens

If you footage is a bit shaky use video stabilization and it will reduce the shakiness
