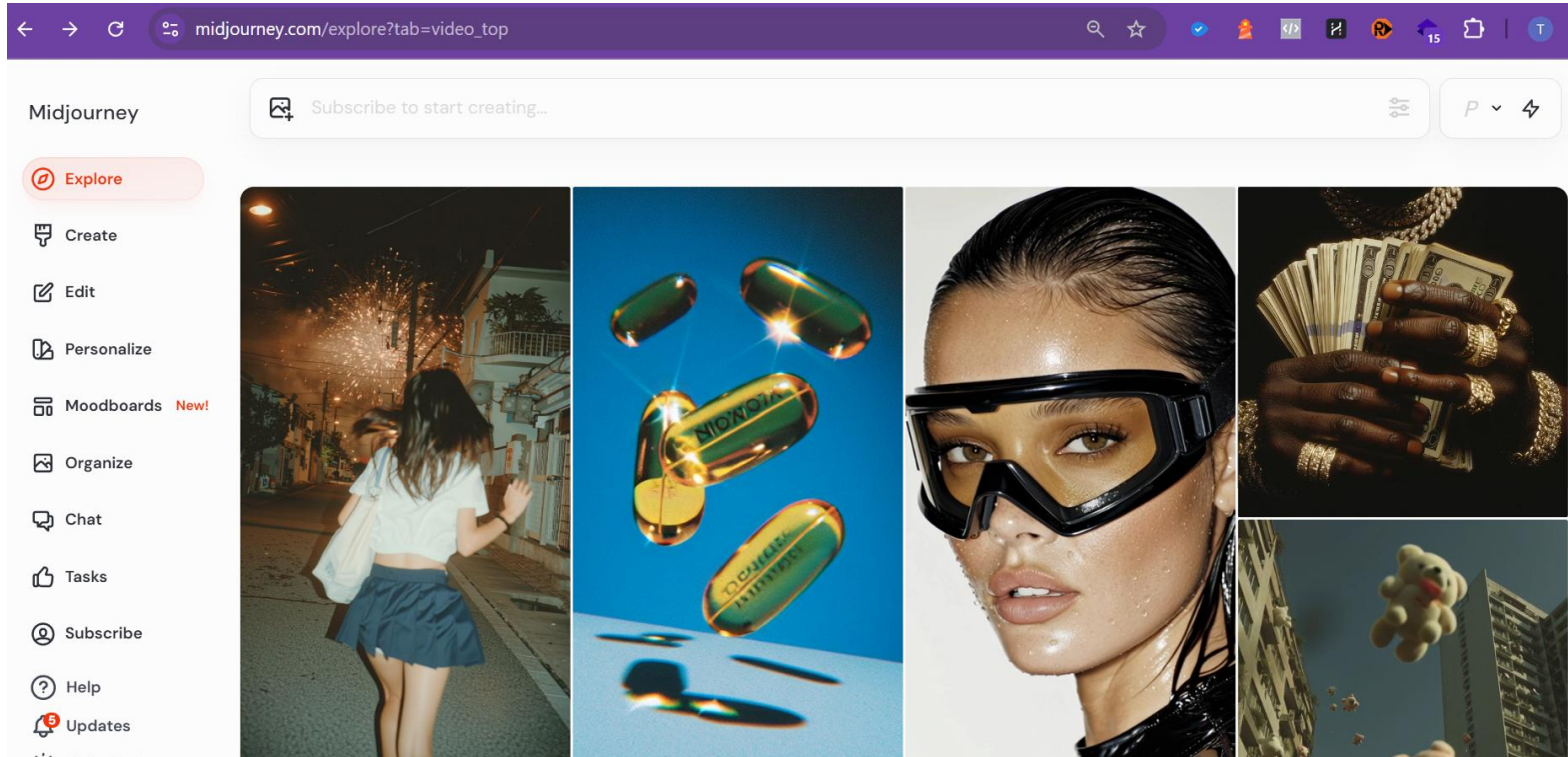

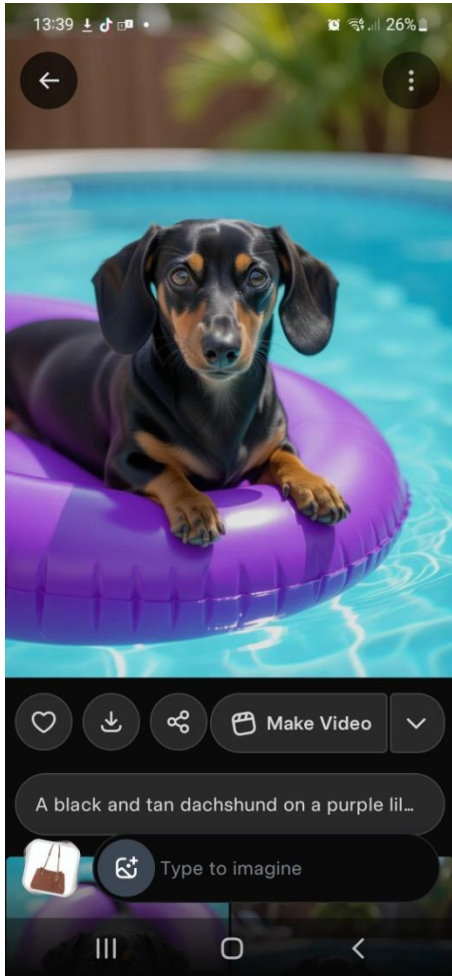
Grok used to be free but stopped offering free in March 2026. However, check it regularly because the will probably go back to free

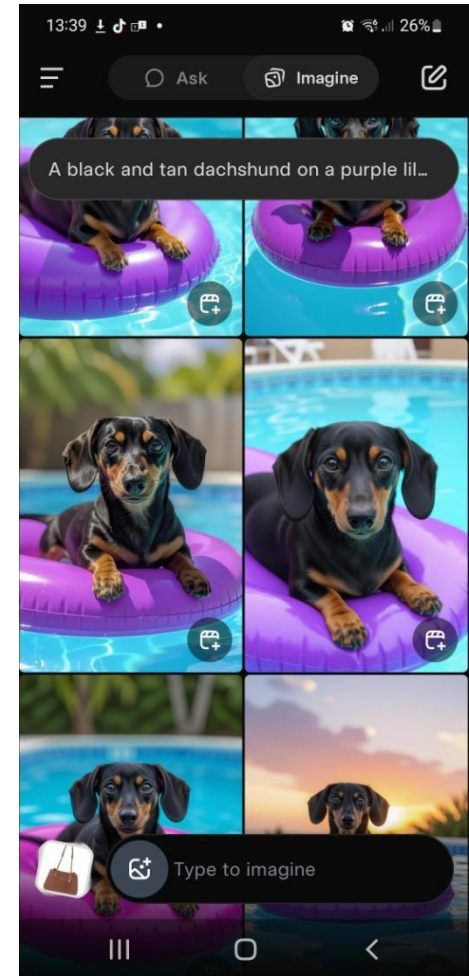

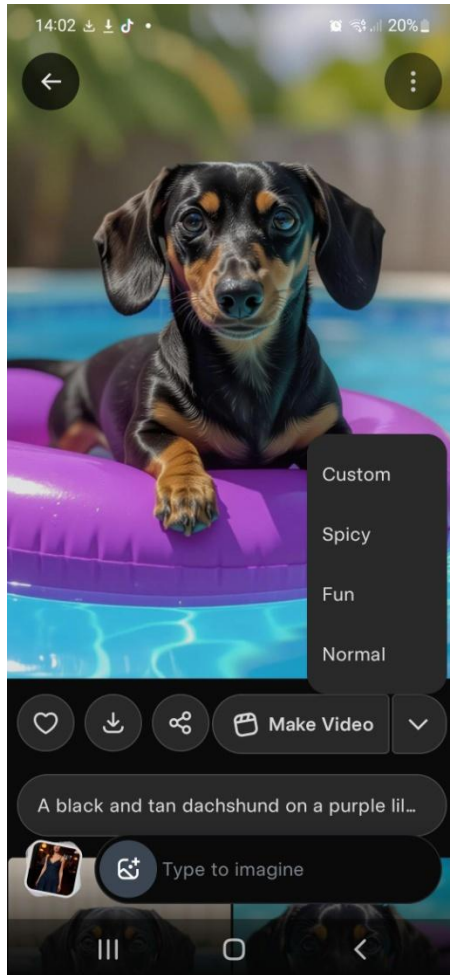

# Turn your images into videos using Grok



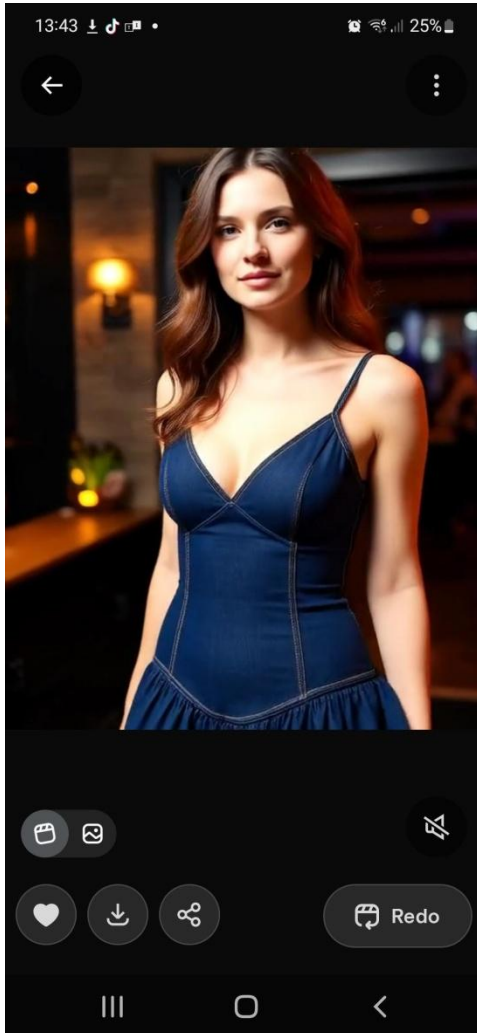
You can turn an image that you created in Grok into a short video which you could use as footage in a marketing video or use it in a Reel

1, Next to make a video tap the arrow  
2. Choose Normal and it will create a normal video

Choose custom and you can include instructions. Choose fun and it will create a fund video

You can then download the video to your phone

You can also attach an image from your phone and it will turn it into a short video

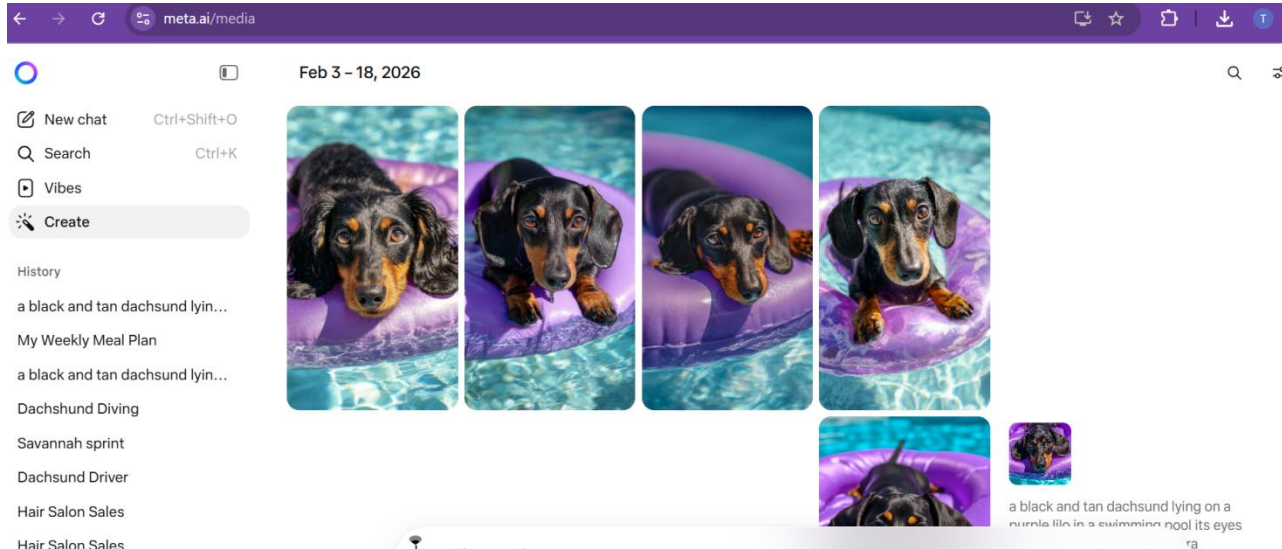
This could be very useful if you attach images of your products

It doesn't have all the useful features of those tools but it does allow you to create free images and videos

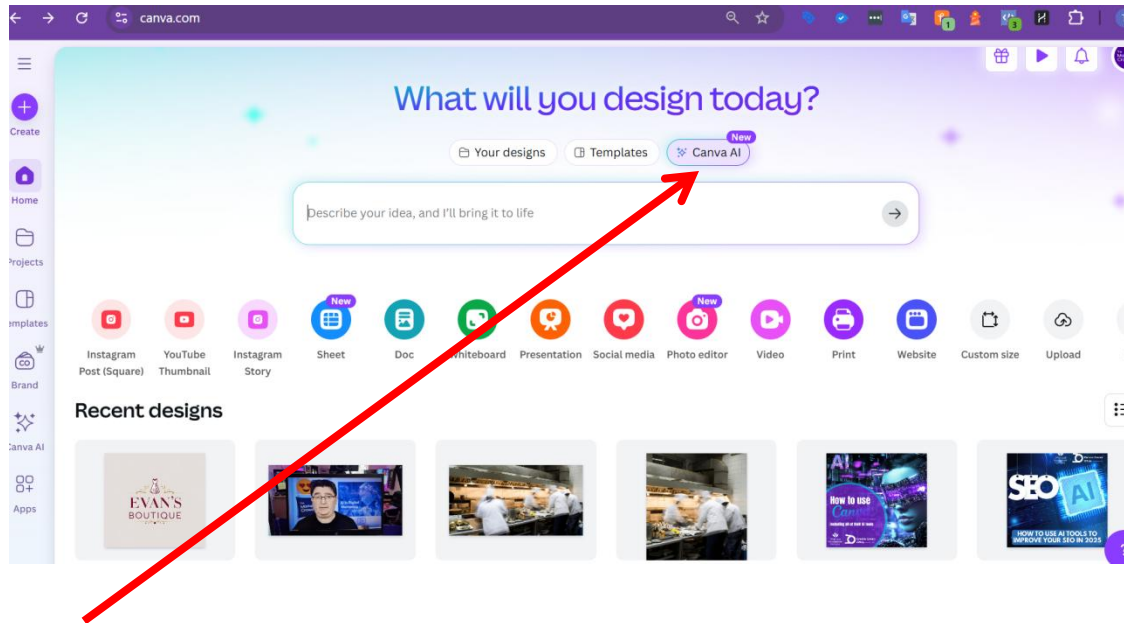

# Image creation in Canva



There is an AI hub located in the centre panel

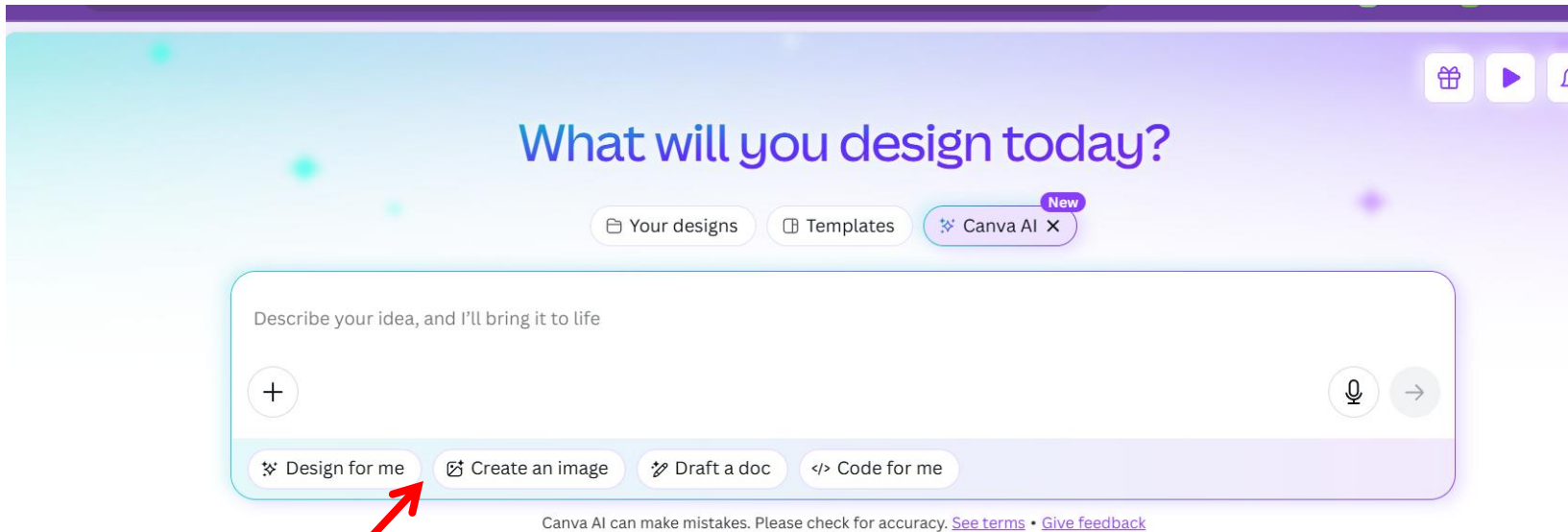
Pro users can use this an unlimited number of times. However, for free users ...

**AI Image Generation:** Free users are allowed 20 lifetime uses of Dream

**Magic Design:** Free accounts have a 10 lifetime use limit for Magic Design features, which includes tools like Magic Design for Presentations

**Other AI Tools:** Free users also have access to Magic Write (Canva's AI text generator), but this is capped at 50 total uses

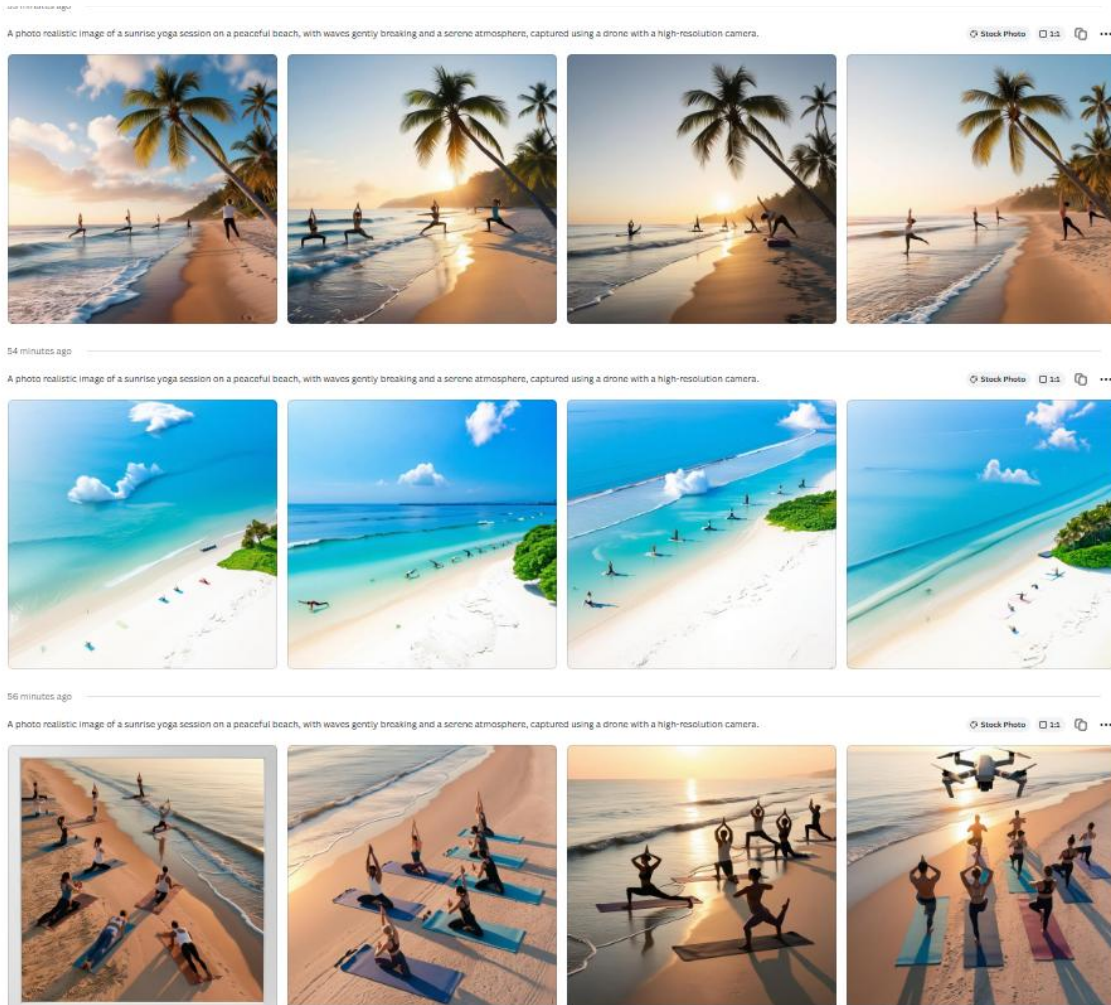

# How do they compare?

## How does this now compare to the old version and the pro version?

### **Nano Banana 1 (Free)**

Very fast

Good quality images

Not good at text on images, translation, infographics, combining lots of attachments into one image

You cannot specify the aspect ratio (9:16 or 16:9)

### **Nano Banana Pro (Paid)**

Not as fast. It takes more time to think.

Highest quality images with high detail. You can output at 2K–4K

You can specify the aspect ratio (9:16 or 16:9)

The image tool is baked into Gemini so it is great at analysing data and turning it into an infographic. Great at generating text on an image, Great at translating text on a image and combining lots of inputs into an image.

### **Nano Banana 2 (Free)**

It is baked into Gemini and has strong reasoning (close to Pro) so you can also create infographics, write text, translate text

You can specify the aspect ratio (9:16 or 16:9)

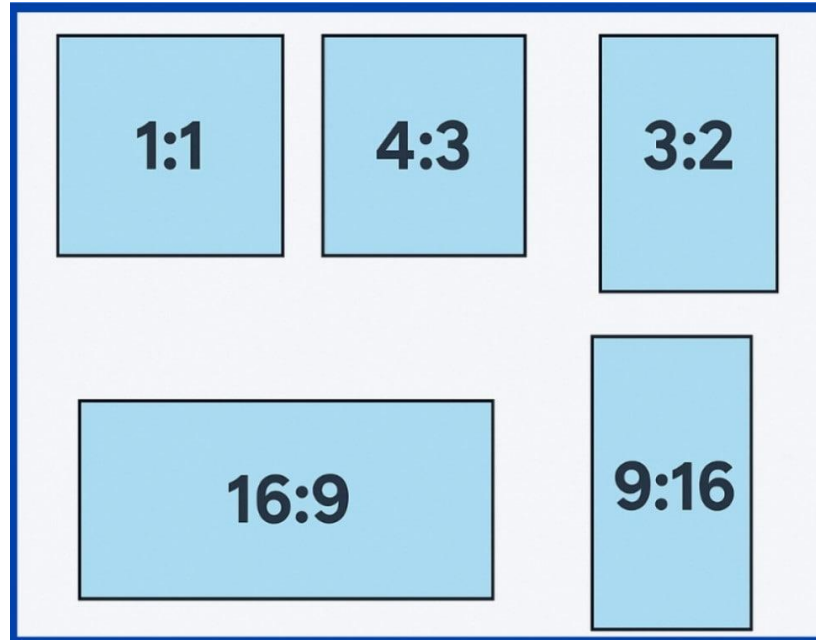
Much faster than Pro

You can output images at 512px to 4K

It is now the default in Gemini. You don't need to choose it.

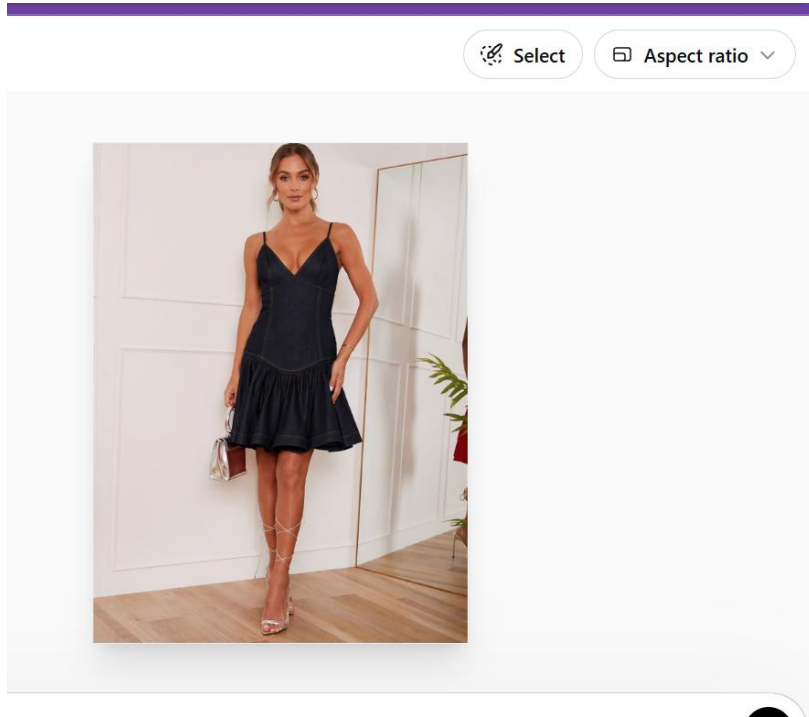

1. Very strong at combining images into one image
2. Excellent with generating text
3. Excellent for infographics
4. Excellent as doing research / analysing information and then creating an image

In most independent tests, Chat GPT 2.0 out performs Nano Banana
